THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

Tage Thompson is riding a five-game goal streak, tied for the longest goal streak of his career.

Thompson has registered eight points (5+3) in that span of games.

A goal today would give **Thompson** the longest goal streak of his career and it would make him the first Sabres skater to register a goal streak of six or more games since Jason Pominville (6 games; Oct. 20 to Nov. 2, 2006).



Rasmus Dahlin has tallied at least one assist in four consecutive games and he has recorded seven assists in that span.

An assist in today's game would give **Dahlin** his seventh assist streak of five or more games in his career.

Mattias Samuelsson is riding a fourgame point streak and he has recorded five points (3+2) and a plus-7 rating in that span.

Alex Tuch has recorded six points (1+5) in his last five games.

In his last two games, Jason Zucker has posted four points (1+3).

A point in today's game would mark the sixth time **Zucker** has tallied five or more points in any three-game span as a member of the Sabres.

Josh Doan has collected five points (3+2) in his last five games.

Bowen Byram has registered six points (3+3) in his last six games.

Jack Quinn is expected to play in his 200th NHL game today.

The Sabres are 11-7-2 all-time on November 23.

November 23, 1978: Larry Playfair makes his NHL debut.

November 23, 2005: Chris Drury records two points (1+1) and Tim Connolly and Ales Kotalik both score shootout goals in a 4-3 victory over the Islanders.

STORM CHASERS

The Sabres have earned four consecutive home wins against the Hurricanes, including a 3-0 shutout win in the last matchup between the two teams in Buffalo on April 8, 2025.

With a win today, Buffalo would match the team's longest home winning streak against the Hurricanes all-time (twice).



Ryan McLeod is riding a six-game point streak against the Hurricanes and he has posted eight points (4+4) in that span.

McLeod has recorded a point in all four of his games against Carolina since joining the Sabres, totaling six points (3+3).

Alex Tuch has recorded at least one point in each of his last four games against the Hurricanes and he has registered five points (3+2) in that span.

A point in today's game would make

Tuch the first Sabres skater since Randy Burridge from Oct. 26, 1996 to Jan. 25, 1997 (five games; 3+3) to record a point streak of five or more games against the Hurricanes.

Tage Thompson has recorded four points (2+2) in his last four games against Carolina.
