MATCHUP NOTES

- ★ Columbus has collected points in three of the last four meetings of the series against Washington (2-1-1).
- ★ The Jackets have recorded a point in seven of their last 12 games at Capital One Arena since Nov. 9, 2018 (6-5-1).
- ★ The road team has won four of the last six games in the series since Dec. 21, 2023.
- ★ The winning team has scored four-plus goals in 10 of the 1st 14 meetings of the all-time series.
- ★ Four of the last five games have seen the winning team win by three or more goals.
- ★ The winning team has scored four-plus goals in 11 of the past 16 dating back to Nov. 12, 2021, including the past three-straight.
- ★ CBJ have killed off 19-of-23 Washington power play chances in the past 11 contests overall (82.6 pct.), along with all 11 opportunities in the six meetings at Capital One Arena.




JACKET TO WATCH - C Sean Monahan

Has 9-10-19 with four multi-point efforts in 25 career GP against the Capitals. Has collected assists in all 5 meetings as a Blue Jacket (1-4-5), including 0-2-2 in 2 GP at Washington.



CAPITAL TO WATCH - LW ALEX OVECHKIN

NHL's all-time goal leader notched has posted 907 goals in career. Has 28-17-45 with 14 multi-point efforts in 51 career GP against the Blue Jackets, including goals in his last five contests (5-4-9).



TEAM NOTES

- ★ CBJ earned a point for the seventh time in the last eight games (4-1-3) in a 4-3 OT loss at Detroit on Saturday.
- ★ The Jackets have played in eight one-goal games in their past nine overall (4-1-3), with six decided after regulation. CBJ have seen 12 of their last 15 contests dating back to Oct. 25 (7-2-3), as well as 15 of the 22 contests in 2025-26 (68.1 pct.), decided by a single goal.
- ★ The club closes out a four-game road trip and a stretch of nine-of-12 games played away from Nationwide Arena from Nov. 2-24 at Washington on Monday.
- ★ Columbus blueliners have combined for 2-8-10 on the first three games of the road trip and lead the NHL in goals scored by defensemen in 2025-26 with 16-31-47.
- ★ CBJ play three of their next four games against Metro Division opponents (Nov. 24 at WSH, Nov. 28 vs. PIT, Dec. 1 at NJD).

PLAYER NOTES

- ★ C **Charlie Coyle** has 1-4-5 in the last six contests and sits one point shy from 500 for his NHL career (192-307-499, 972 GP).
- ★ C **Adam Fantilli** notched a goal on Saturday and has tallied goals in six of the past eight games (7-2-9) and points in seven of the last nine (7-4-11).
- ★ LW **Dmitri Voronkov** has goals in three of the past five games (3-2-5) and leads the team in goals (tied), PPG and plus/minus rating (tied) this season with 9-9-18, 3 PPG and +8 in 22 contests.
- ★ D **Zach Werenski** has notched three multi-point efforts during a six-game points streak (3-7-10) after posting 1-1-2 on Saturday. The Grosse Pointe, Michigan native ranks second in the NHL in TOI/GP as well as leads league blueliners in shots on goal and ranks second-T in goals and multi-point efforts as well as third in points with 7-14-21, 7 multi-point GP, 85 shots and 26:50 TOI in 22 contests.
- ★ C **Adam Fantilli** (7-7-14, 13 GP), RW **Kirill Marchenko** (6-7-13, 13 GP) and D **Zach Werenski** (4-8-12, 13 GP) lead the club in scoring on the road.
