TEAM NOTES

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP

• The Maple Leafs advanced to the Second Round of the 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs with a Game 6 win against the Ottawa Senators on May 1st. Toronto will take on the Florida Panthers in the Second Round, marking the second postseason meeting between the clubs in franchise history. Florida won the first postseason meeting against Toronto in the Second Round of the 2023 Stanley Cup Playoffs. The Panthers won in five games [4-1], outscoring the Maple Leafs 14-10 through five meetings. The Maple Leafs are skating in their first game of the series tonight as they take on the Panthers at Scotiabank Arena. The Maple Leafs have posted a 35-48 record in Game I's in franchise bestof-seven series (20-13 at home). Through six games in the 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs, William Nylander leads the team in points with nine (3G, 6A) while Mitch Marner leads the team in assists with seven. Matthew Knies, John Tavares and William Nylander are tied for the lead in goals with three.

LAST GAME

• The Maple Leafs won 4-2 against the Senators on Thursday night at Canadian Tire Centre, clinching the First Round series against Ottawa in six games. William Nylander scored twice in Toronto's win with Auston Matthews (PP) and Max Pacioretty (GWG) also adding a goal each for the Maple Leafs. Nylander marked the 14th multi-point game of his playoff career and tied a single-game postseason career-high in points with three (2G, 1A) which he has marked on three occasions during his playoff career. Pacioretty also added an assist for Toronto, marking the 11th multi-point game of his playoff career. Pontus Holmberg registered the secondary assist on Pacioretty's goal, posting the first point of his playoff career. Anthony Stolarz stopped 21 of 23 shots he faced in Thursday's win.
