# AT A GLANCE

#### **KING OF KINGS**

With 63 points (18-45=63) in 65 appearances, Anze Kopitar has the most career points against Colorado of any active skater in the League. The Kings' captain is the franchise leader in both assists and points against the organization and ranks second in team history in goals scored against the Nordiques/Avalanche franchise behind only Luc Robitaille (32). Kopitar (0-1=1) picked up his 39th assist of the season on Tuesday against New York, extending his point streak to a third game (2-2=4) dating to March 22 against Carolina. The assist marked his 1,268th career point (437-831=1,268), passing Jean Ratelle (491-776=1,267) for sole possession of the 41st most points in NHL history, and marked his 831st career assist, which passes Henrik Sedin for sole possession of 28th all time.

#### **PHIL-LING UP THE NET**

Forward Phillip Danault played in his 700th career game on Tuesday at Crypto.com Arena, becoming the 25th skater selected in the 2011 NHL Draft to reach the milestone and is also the sixth Quebec-born skater to skate in his 700th career game as a member of the Kings. Danault (1-0=1) potted the eventual gamewinning goal in Tuesday's win against the Rangers to extend his point streak to a third game (1-2=3), dating to Saturday against Carolina.

#### SWISS-SATIONAL

Forward Kevin Fiala (2-0=2) scored twice in Tuesday night's victory over the New York Rangers, accounting for his 49th and 50th points (28-22=50) of the campaign to clinch his fifth career 50-point season. Fiala becomes the third Swiss-born player in League history to record three or more 50-point seasons, joining **Roman Josi** (8x) and **Nico Hischier** (5x). He looks to build on his current five-point (3-2=5), three-game point streak during tonight's trip to the Mile High City. Since joining the Kings, the forward has registered three points (1-2=3) in four visits to Ball Arena and has scored 10 goals and 22 points (10-12=22) across 31 career appearances against the Colorado Avalanche.
