TEAM NOTES

- ★ The Blue Jackets picked up points for the third-consecutive game overall (2-0-1) and have won four of their past five contests at Nationwide Arena.
- ★ Columbus (1-0-1) and Edmonton (1-1-0) split the 2025-26 season series tonight with both teams winning their respective home games.
- ★ The Jackets have posted five-straight wins against the Oilers at Nationwide Arena since Apr. 24, 2022, outscoring the club 26-to-15 in those games and scoring five goals or more in four of them after tonight.
- ★ The Blue Jackets scored the first goal of the game for the eighth time this season and are 6-1-1 when doing so in 2025-26.
- ★ Columbus stopped both of Edmonton's power play chances tonight and is 17-for-18 (94.4 pct.) on the penalty kill in the last nine games overall since Oct. 28.
- ★ The Blue Jackets scored in all three periods for the eighth time this season tonight and posted their 10th multi-goal frame of the season after netting three in the second period.
- ★ The Jackets won 35-of-59 (59.3 pct.) face-offs taken tonight for the third-highest winning percentage of the season.
- ★ Columbus played in front of their second sellout crowd of the season tonight at Nationwide Arena (Oct. 13 vs. NJD).

PLAYER NOTES

- ★ **C Charlie Coyle** (3-9-12, 17 GP) posted his second three-point game of the season (0-4-4 on Oct. 29 vs. TOR) tonight with 1-2-3 and has picked up 2-6-8 in his last eight games this season. He improved to 8-12-20 in 33 career matchups against Edmonton after posting his third multi-point effort vs. the club tonight.
- ★ **LW Luca Del Bel Belluz** (0-1-1, 4 GP) collected his first point of the season with an assist on Matychuk's goal.
- ★ **C Adam Fantilli** (5-7-12, 17 GP) extended his goal streak to three consecutive and points streak to four-straight (3-3-6) with his second period goal tonight. He is now seven points shy of 100 for his NHL/CBJ career. He picked up 2-1-3 against the Oilers in 2025-26 season series and improved to 3-3-6 in five career games against the club, with all points in the last four-straight meetings.
- ★ **D Denton Mateychuk** (4-3-7, 16 GP) tied Zach Werenski for the team lead in goals among defensemen and has picked up 2-2-4 in his past six games played. His four goals have already matched his career-high set last season (4-9-13, 45 GP).
- ★ **RW Kirill Marchenko** (8-11-19, 17 GP) extended his career-high points streak to 10 games with an assist on Fantilli's goal to become the fifth different player in Blue Jackets history with a point streak of 10 or more games. The other players who have posted a streak of 10 games or longer are: Ryan Johansen (13 GP in 2014-15 and 10 GP in 2014-15), Cam Atkinson (12 GP in 2018-19), Patrik Laine (11 GP in 2021-22) and R.J. Umberger (10 GP in 2010-11). Marchenko improved his career mark against Edmonton to 3-4-7 in eight career outings with assists in both games of the 2025-26 series and has posted assists in three of his last four games (0-4-4).
- ★ **C Sean Monahan** (2-7-9, 17 GP) stretched his points streak to three games (1-2-3). He has registered 15-14-29 in 47 career games vs. the Oilers, including 4-1-5 in his last five against the club.
- ★ **RW Mathieu Olivier** (3-5-8, 17 GP) scored twice and assisted on another for his second three-point game of the campaign tonight (1-3-4, Oct. 29 vs. TOR). He improved to 4-1-5 in seven career games against the Oilers with all points coming in his four career matchups at Nationwide Arena.
- ★ **LW Cole Sillinger** (2-5-7, 16 GP) collected an assist on Olivier's second goal of the game. He has collected 3-7-10 in nine career outings against Edmonton, with points in his last four-straight contests against the club (2-5-7).
- ★ **D Damon Severson** (1-4-5, 17 GP) tallied an assist for the second time in the last three games (0-2-2).
- ★ **D Zach Werenski** (4-8-12, 17 GP) notched an assist tonight and is now four points shy of 400 for his NHL/CBJ career (117-279-396, 584 GP). He improved to 1-9-10 in 14 career games against Edmonton, including points in seven of his last eight games overall (1-6-7).
