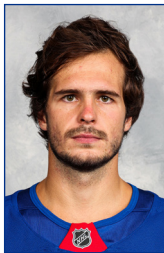

TOP NOTES

As a result of his goal, **Jack Quinn** is now riding a five-game point streak (2+4) against New York. It marked his second unassisted goal of the season and the second of his career (Oct. 26, 2024 vs. Detroit).

Rasmus Dahlin's first goal extended his point streak to six games and he has posted 11 points (3+8) in that span. With his first goal, **Dahlin** passed Mike Ramsey and gained sole possession of second-place on Buffalo's all-time list for goals by a defenseman (74).

Jordan Greenway registered the lone assist on **Dahlin's** first goal and he has recorded four points (1+3) in his last four games against Rangers.

Tage Thompson's first goal made him the first Sabres skater to record a goal streak of three or more games within a single season against the Rangers since Miroslav Satan did so from Oct. 17, 2002 to Feb. 15, 2003 (three games; 6+1). **Thompson** is the third Sabres skater to do so since 1981 (J.P. Dumont; three games; Dec. 8, 2000 to March 14, 2001; 5+0).

Dahlin's second goal of the game marked the fourth time he had recorded multiple goals in a game in his career. Before tonight's game, he last did so on March 19, 2024 at Vancouver.

Jason Zucker registered three assists in tonight's game and his first marked his first point streak of five or more games since he recorded one point in five consecutive games from Feb. 22 to March 3, 2019 (3+2) as a member of the Minnesota Wild. **Zucker** has tallied eight points (2+6) during his current five-game point streak and he now has 200 NHL assists in his career.

JJ Peterka's assist on **Thompson's** first goal gave him one point in eight consecutive games against New York. As a result, he became the first Sabres skater since Phil Housley (nine games; Feb. 20, 1987 to Nov. 22, 1989; 2+14), and the first Sabres forward since Dave Andreychuk (eight games; Dec. 18, 1985 to March 4, 1988; 4+6), to register at least one point in eight or more consecutive games against the Rangers.

In eight career games against the Rangers including his two goals in tonight's contest, **Ryan McLeod** has tallied nine points (4+5).

Buffalo's five first-period goals were the most the team had recorded in the first period of a game since Dec. 7, 2022 at Columbus (six).
