The Islanders continue their seven-game road trip in Winnipeg (1-0-1 so far) where they are looking to extend their point streak to a season-high-tying five games. The Islanders are coming off a 4-3 overtime win against the Minnesota Wild on Saturday night where they improved to a perfect 5-0-0 in overtime this season and a season-high 10 games over NHL-.500. Four of the Islanders last six games have permitted an extra frame. New York is 3-1-1 in January, went 9-4-1 in December and are 21-10-4 in their last 35 games. It is the final of two meetings on the season against the Jets, the Islanders taking a 5-2 loss at UBS Arena on October 13 to start their season 0-3-0. The Islanders are 9-3-0 in their last 12 games against the Jets dating back to March 28, 2019, outscoring the club 41-27 in that span, and are also 9-3-0 in their last 12 road games to Winnipeg (since 4/20/13). The Isles have gone 25-12-5 since starting the season 0-3-0. Since their first win on October 16 their 55 points are the second-most in the Eastern Conference and the fifth-most in the league, trailing only Colorado's 67 points, Minnesota's 57 points, Dallas' 57 points and Tampa Bay's 56 points. The Islanders are 11-7-3 on the road and 5-5-1 against Central Division teams.

Lee has 26 points (17 goals, nine assists) in 23 career games against Winnipeg. He leads all active NHL players with a +17 rating against the club. Lee has recorded a point in 19 of those 23 contests, including a point in four of his last five meetings against the club (three goals, three assists). He has recorded more points against the Jets than any other Western Conference team in his career. He made his NHL debut on April 2, 2013 against the Jets and recorded his first career goal that day.

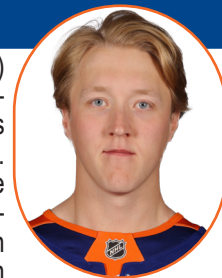

PLAYER SPOTLIGHT

SIMON HOLMSTROM #10



Simon Holmstrom has recorded 23 points (12G, 11A) in 44 games this season. He has scored a goal in a career-high-tying three consecutive games with five points in that span and has 10 points over his last 10 games. On January 10, he tallied his second three-point game (2G, 1A) of the season, including his first career overtime score. His first goal of the night marked his 100th career point and he is one of three Islander players with multiple three-point games this season (also: Anders Lee, 3x and Mat Barzal, 2x). The Islanders are 8-1-2 when Simon Holmstrom has scored a goal this season and 12-2-3 when he has found the scoresheet. He has a 24.0% shot rate (12-for-50), which is the best by an Islanders skater this season (min. 10 SOG) and is the highest successful shot percentage in the league among skaters with at least 50 shots on goal. Of the 690 skaters who have attempted more than 100 shots on goal since Holmstrom entered the league in 2022-23, his 20.6 career shot percentage is the best in the NHL. Since 2023-24, Holmstrom's 14 shorthanded points are tied with Jean-Gabriel Pageau, Mika Zibanejad and Sam Reinhart for the league lead.
