## NOTES:

**SAN DIEGO** is tied for the longest active win streak in the AHL (4-0-0) and is 5-1-1 since returning from the All-Star break. The Gulls are also 6-3-1 the last 10 contests overall.

**TRISTAN LUNEAU** leads AHL defensemen in points per game (.89 min. 30 GP) while ranking sixth in assists (25) and ninth in scoring (6-25=31). He also leads active AHL rookie defensemen in assists and ranks third in points and goals while ranking second among all league rookies in assists. Luneau is riding a four-game point streak (1-4=5) and has posted points in 11 of his last 13 contests (5-16=21), including a four-game multi-point streak Jan. 15-26 (4-7=11). Since Jan. 1, Luneau leads all AHL defenseman and all AHL rookies in points (5-19=23). In that same span, he also leads all AHL skaters in assists and ranks tied for fourth among all AHL skaters. He leads San Diego skaters in assists while also leading Gulls defensemen in scoring.

**OSCAR DANSK** has posted four consecutive wins to help the Gulls improve to 5-1-1 in the month of February. He recorded assists in back-to-back games Feb. 16 and Feb. 19 to mark the first time in Gulls history multiple goalies have recorded multiple points in a single season (also: Clang, 2024-25; 0-2=2).



**SASHA PASTUJOV** recorded a career-high and Gulls record 13-game point streak Jan.3-Feb. 8, the longest point streak in the AHL this season (5-14=19). He was named AHL Player of the month after tallying 6-13=19 points in 12 January contests, the first player in Gulls AHL history to receive the honor. Pastujov has posted points in 21 of his last 24 games (11-20=31), including an AHL career-high four-assist game Jan. 8 vs. Iowa (0-4=4). Pastujov co-leads Gulls skaters in points-per-game (1.00), while ranking second in points (14-20=34), goals and power-play goals (5).

**SAM COLANGELO** leads AHL rookies in points per game (1.00) while ranking second in goals (19) and sixth in scoring (19-16=35). He is one of two AHL rookies at a point-per-game pace this season (also: Frank Nazar Rockford). Colangelo has recorded 5-5=10 points in seven games since returning from the AHL All-Star Classic where he made his debut, taking part in the skills competition and All-Star Challenge. He had a three-game goal streak Feb.7-11 (4-0=4) and is currently riding a three-game point streak (1-5=6). He has points in six of his last seven games (5-5=10) and 9-9=18 points his last 17 contests. He paces Gulls skaters in scoring, goals and points-per-game.

## NOTES:

**BECKETT SENNECKE** ranks fifth among OHL leaders in goals (35), eighth in points-per-game (1.68), tied for eighth in PPG (11) and 10th in scoring (35-44=79). He leads the Generals in points and goals while rankings third in assists. Sennecke recorded his third hat trick of the season Feb. 14 at Brampton (3-0=3) and is currently riding a seven-game point streak (6-5=11). Sennecke has already set OHL single-season highs in points, goals and assists output from last season. He is on pace for 44 goals and 99 points after scoring 27 goals and 68 points in 63 games last season.

**ALEXANDRE BLAIS** ranks tied for third among QMJHL leaders in assists (45). He leads Rimouski skaters in assists while ranking second in scoring (19-45=64). Blais is currently riding a three-game point streak (1-5=6) and has 3-11=12 points his last seven contests, 3-11=14 his last 10 and 3-16=19 his last 13.

**TARIN SMITH** ranks tied for sixth among WHL defensemen in goals (14), seventh in scoring (14-35=49), ninth with a +30 rating and 10th in assists. Smith had a season-long seven-game point streak Jan. 25-Feb. 7 (5-7=12). Smith has surpassed his 2023-24 totals in points (44) and goals (8), and is one assist from matching his output in assists after scoring 5-8=13 points his last 11 outings.

**ETHAN PROCYSZYN** ranks third among OHL leaders in PPG (15). He leads North Bay in scoring (29-22=51) and goals while ranking third in assists and had a five-game point streak Feb. 6-15 (3-4=7).

**DAMIAN CLARA** was loaned to Karpat of the Finnish Liiga Feb. 14. He stopped 31-of-32 shots in a 2-1 win in his Karpat debut, Feb. 19 vs. KooKoo.

**LUCAS PETTERSSON** ranks fourth among Allsvenskan skaters 19 and under in scoring (8-9=17) and goals while ranking fifth in assists. He ranks tied for third among Ostersunds IK leaders in scoring and goals and fifth in assists. Pettersson represented Sweden U19 at the International Junior Games, tallying three goals through four games.

**ARTYOM GALIMOV** ranks second in the KHL in goals (29), tied for fourth with a +24 rating, sixth in scoring (29-22=51) and 10th in points-per-game (0.91). He became the ninth player to score hat trick in a first period in KHL history with his natural hat trick recorded Feb. 2 at St. Petersburg (3-1=4). Galimov had a season-long eight-game point streak Jan. 3-20 (5-4=9) and has recorded 7-3=10 points his last nine contests.

**DARELS ULJANSKIS** made his debut with AIK of the HockeyAllsvenskan league Feb. 18 vs. Vasteras IK. He has recorded 6-21=27 points in 36 games with AIK J20 this season.
