

TOP NOTES

Peyton Krebs' goal gave him one point in back-to-back games (1+1). It marked the 10th time, and the first since he registered one point in consecutive games from April 9 to 11, 2024 (0+2), that he has registered at least one point in two straight games in his career.

Beck Malenstyn registered the primary assist on Krebs' goal and has now recorded one point in each of his last two games (1+1). It marked the first time he has tallied at least one point in consecutive games since he recorded an assist in back-to-back games from Jan. 5 to 7, 2024 with Washington.

As a result of his second-period goal, Ryan McLeod has now recorded one point in each of his last five games (4+1), which extended the longest point streak of his career.

McLeod has recorded a goal in four consecutive games, which is the longest goal streak of his career.

Jason Zucker's primary assist on McLeod's goal gave him five assists in his last five games including tonight's contest.

Owen Power registered three assists in tonight's game, which matched his single-game career high. He last accomplished the feat on April 6, 2023 at Detroit.

Tonight's game marked the 11th multi-assist performance of Power's career and his first since March 14, 2024 vs. the New York Islanders (0+2).

Tage Thompson's goal gave him his first point streak of five or more games since he notched at least one point in five consecutive games from March 16 to 24, 2024 (3+4). He has recorded seven points (4+3) during his current streak. In his last seven games against the Stars including tonight, Thompson has registered nine points (3+6).

With his assist on Thompson's goal and his own empty-net goal, Alex Tuch has now recorded nine points (3+6) in his last seven games, including five points (3+2) in his last three home contests and at least one point in each of his last two games (2+1).

Tuch's goal marked the 14th empty-net tally of his career and his second of the season (Oct. 12 vs. Florida).
