

TOP NOTES

As a result of his goal, **JJ Peterka** has tallied 11 points (6+5) in his last 10 games, including eight points (5+3) in his last six home contests.

Dylan Cozens picked up the primary assist on **Peterka** and **Alex Tuch's** goals and the secondary assist on **Henri Jokiharju's** game-winning goal.

Cozens' three assists in tonight's game matched his previous career high. He has now registered nine points (2+7) in his last six games against Anaheim, including at least one point in each of his last three home games against the Ducks (1+5).

Owen Power's assist on **Peterka's** goal gave him one assist in three consecutive games. It marked his fifth assist streak of three or more games this season.

With his goal, **Tuch** has collected nine points (4+5) in his last six games. **Tuch** has recorded seven points (3+4) in six games against the Ducks as a member of the Sabres.

Tuch's goal was his 20th of the season, which marked the fourth time he has reached the 20-goal mark in a single season in his career.

Jokiharju's goal gave him one goal in back-to-back games. It marked the first time he had recorded a goal in consecutive games in his career. The goal was the third game-winning goal of **Jokiharju's** career (Oct. 12, 2024 vs. Florida; Feb. 17, 2024 at Minnesota).

The Sabres are now riding a six-game home winning streak and their win tonight gave them a win in six straight home games for the first time since Nov. 3 to 27, 2018 (six games).

Including the above home winning streaks, Buffalo has earned six straight home wins four times since 1999 (Jan. 17 to Feb. 15, 2007; Nov. 28 to Dec. 15, 2014).

Tonight's win marked just the 15th time in Sabres' history that Buffalo trailed by two or more goals entering the third period of a game and earned a regulation win. It was the first time the Sabres had done so since Nov. 24, 2023 vs. Pittsburgh.
