KINGS NOTES

- Forward **Joel Armia** (1-1=2) scored his first goal as a member of the LA Kings a few minutes prior to adding his fifth assist of the campaign, his fourth and fifth points (1-4=5) of the season. Armia is the 15th Finnish skater to score a goal for the Kings in franchise history.
 - Winger **Adrian Kempe** (1-0=1) scored his fifth goal of the season to extend his away goal and point streaks to a fifth game (5-4=9), dating back to Oct. 11 in Winnipeg. Kempe's stretch of five consecutive road games with a goal is tied for the longest such streak since **Adam Deadmarsh** (8 G) scored in six straight road games from Feb. 26 – March 18, 2002.
 - Kempe now has 199 career goals and will be the 10th player in franchise history to record 200 goals in a Kings uniform the next time that he finds the back of the net. With fellow 2014 NHL Draftee **Kevin Fiala** scoring his 200th career goal on March 1, 2025, Kempe and Fiala can become the first pair of Kings teammates to record their 200th career goal in the same calendar year since **Anze Kopitar** (April 4, 2014) and **Dustin Brown** (Nov. 26, 2014) did so more than a decade ago.
 - Forward **Corey Perry** (1-0=1) recorded his second goal in his last two games, becoming the first player in Kings history to score in consecutive appearances at age 40 or older, per NHL PR.
 - Winger **Trevor Moore** (1-0=1) scored his third goal of the season and now has points in three straight visits to Bridgestone Arena (1-2=3), dating back to Jan. 31, 2024.
 - Defenseman **Brandt Clarke** (0-2=2) recorded his second and third assists of the campaign, his third and fourth career points against the Predators (0-4=4) in six total contests. Tonight also marked Clarke's seventh career multi-point game, tying **Mark Hardy** for the 11th most by a blueliner age 22 or younger in franchise history.
 - Winger **Andrei Kuzmenko** (0-1=1) tallied his fourth helper of the season, his seventh point (3-4=7) in 10 career matchups with the Nashville Predators.
- Forward **Alex Turcotte** (0-1=1) posted his second assist of the year on Armia's game-tying goal in the second period. Turcotte has three points (1-2=3) in four career games at Bridgestone Arena, including his first career goal on Jan. 31, 2024.
- Defenseman **Joel Edmundson** (0-1=1) notched his second assist of the season on Moore's third period marker, his second assist in his past two visits to Nashville.
