PRESEASON NOTES

- The Flyers played their fourth of seven preseason games on Saturday, Sept. 28 at Wells Fargo Center, defeating the Boston Bruins 3-2 in overtime. Philadelphia will play four games on the road and three contests at home this preseason.
- Since the 2011-12 season, Philadelphia is 32-30-18 in 80 preseason games, not including 2019's preseason match-up against Lausanne at Vaudoise Arena in Prilly, Switzerland (4-3 L). The Flyers are 24-10-8 in front of a home crowd and 8-20-10 on the road in preseason games since 2011-12.
- The Flyers opened their 2024 Training Camp with 58 players - 32 forwards, 20 defensemen and six goaltenders.
- Philadelphia went 3-2-1 in six preseason match-ups last season, including a 2-0-1 home record and a 1-2-0 road record.
- The Flyers will open their 2024-25 regular season on the road for the second consecutive season since 2018-19 campaign.
- Philadelphia's home opener will take place on Saturday, Oct. 19 vs. Vancouver - the second consecutive year the Flyers face the Canucks in their home opener.

THE MAD ABOUT MATVEI

- **Matvei Michkov**, Philadelphia's 2023 first-round draft pick, made his NHL preseason debut against Washington (9/22).
- In his third preseason game on Sept. 28, he scored two goals for Philadelphia including the game-winning goal in overtime. This marked his third multi-point game this preseason.
- He is tied for the leagues lead in points this preseason (3g-3a) in just three contests. Additionally, he leads all Flyers in points this preseason.
- The right-winger registered his first two assists in his official Flyers preseason debut for his first multi-point game in the preseason (9/22).
- Last season in the KHL, he led the team in goals (19), ranked second in points (41) and third in assists (22) in the 2023-24 season.
- The 19-year-old owned 11 multi-point games in the 2023-24 season.
- He posted a season-high four-game point streak (3g-4a) from Sept. 30-Oct. 7, 2023

BUZZIN' WITH BEEZER

- **Joel Farabee** tallied four points (1g-3a) in the contest against Washington (9/22) for his first multi-point game of the preseason.
- The New York native owned career highs in 2023-24 in goals (22), assists (28), points (50), power-play points (7), and game-winning goals (2).
- He ranked tied for second on the Flyers in first goals of the game (6), third in goals and points, and tied for third in assists.
- The forward notched his 100th NHL career assist on March 21 at Carolina.
- He registered a career-high seven-game point streak (5-5=10) from Jan. 12-23, 2024.
- Farabee skated in his 300th NHL game on Jan. 23 vs. Tampa Bay.

BOBBIN' AND WEAVIN'

- **Bobby Brink** scored two goals in Philadelphia's preseason opener against Washington, his first multi-point game this preseason.
- He enters his third NHL season with the Flyers.
- The right wing tied for fourth among NHL rookies in game-winning goals (2) during the 2023-24 season.
- He recorded back-to-back multi-point games for the first time in his career (2-2=4) from Oct. 26-28, 2023.
- The Minnesota native netted his first career goals (2-0=2) on Oct. 26, 2023 vs. Minnesota, where his first NHL goal marked the first time in team history a Flyer scored their first goal as a power-play game-winning goal.

A FIRST FOR SOME FIRST....ROUNDERS, THAT IS

- **Jett Luchanko**, Philadelphia's 2024 first-round draft pick, made his NHL preseason debut on 9/22 against Washington.
 - The 18-year-old notched his first two NHL preseason assists, marking his first multi-assist game in an NHL preseason.
 - He collected 74 points (20g-54a) in 68 regular season games in 2023-24 with the Guelph Storm of the OHL.
 - The right-shot center led the Guelph in assists and points, tied for third in shorthanded goals, ranked fifth in goals and sixth in power-play goal in 2023-24.
 - He was awarded the William Hanley Trophy for the OHL's most sportsmanlike player.
 - The forward represented Team Canada in the 2024 Under-18 World Junior Championship, posting two goals and five assists for seven points in seven games to win a gold medal.
- **Oliver Bonk**, Philadelphia's 2023 first-round draft pick, made his 2024 NHL preseason debut on 9/23 against Montréal.
 - The 19-year-old right handed defenseman appeared in his first game of the 2024 preseason, marking his second career NHL



preseason game dating back to the 2023 season.

- He collected 67 points (24g-43a) in 60 regular season games in 2023-24 with the London Knights of the OHL.
- The young defenseman led OHL defenseman in power-play goals (15) and ranked second in power-play points (33), third in goals and fifth in points.
- Ranked second on the Knights in power-play goals, sixth in assists and points and seventh in goals.
- He posted 19 multi-point games during the regular season.
- Led all Knights defensemen in points (16) in the 2023-24 playoffs en route to a J. Ross Robertson Cup.

FROSTING OVER

- **Morgan Frost** posted three points (2g-1a) for Philadelphia in his preseason opener against Washington.
- He tallied 14 points (4-10=14) in the last 23 games of the 2023-24 season, including four multi-point performances.
- The center posted a career-high six-game points streak (3-5=8) from March 12-23, 2024.
- He netted his first career penalty shot goal on Feb. 12, 2024 vs. Arizona.
- The Ontario native skated in his 200th NHL game on Feb. 10, 2024 vs. Seattle.
- His second assist on Jan. 20 vs. Colorado marked his 20th point of the season to reach 20-plus points for his second consecutive season.
- The 24-year-old led the team in 2023-24 with a career-high 11 power-play points and ranked tied for third with a career-high three power-play goals.

WALKING ON ERR

- **Sam Ersson** recorded a shutout, stopping all 37 shots he faced in his 2024 NHL preseason debut on 9/26 against NY Islanders.
- Last season, the goaltender recorded a (23-19-7) record across 51 games, posting a goals-against average (GAA) of 2.82 and a save percentage of .890, along with four shutouts.
- The Swedish native enters his second season full-season with the Flyers following a successful rookie year where he was tied for the league lead in wins (23), shutouts (4) and played in the most games (51) among all rookie goaltenders.

OL' MAN JOHNSON

- **Erik Johnson** broke open the flood gates when he scored the first goal of the game in the third period of the preseason game against NY Islanders on 9/26.
- Johnson made his 2024 preseason debut as he enters his first full-season with the Flyers.
- Last season, the 6-foot-4, 225-pound blueliner was acquired from Buffalo at the 2023 trade deadline.
- During his time with the Flyers, he registered (2g-1a) across 17 games.
- A native of Bloomington, Minn., is a veteran of 987 regular season games over parts of 17 seasons in the NHL with St. Louis, Colorado and the Flyers (2007-08, 2009-24). He has posted 93 goals and 250 assists for 340 points and 538 penalty minutes.

KONNECT FOUR

- **Travis Konecny** tallied two assists on Saturday in the win over Boston.
- In both his preseason appearances, he has led all forwards in time-on-ice (TOI). Registering 18:42 on 9/26 vs. New York and 21:03 on 9/28 vs. Boston
- Last season, the 27-year-old winger led the Flyers in goals (33), shorthanded goals (6), game-winning goals (5), assists (35), points (68) and first goals of the game (7) while leading the NHL in shorthanded goals.
- His sixth shorthanded goal of the season on Apr. 13 vs. New Jersey marked his 400th career NHL point, all with Philadelphia. He became the 21st player in team history to reach the 400-point plateau
- The London, Ontario native was named an alternate captain on Feb. 14

LUCKY LYCKSELL

- **Olle Lycksell** tallied two primary assists on Saturday in the win over Boston. His first multi-assist game this preseason.
- This preseason he is tied for third in points (1g-2a) and also leads the Flyers in shots (11).
- Last season, the 6-foot winger skated in 18 contests for the Flyers. He contributed (1g-4a) in his appearances.
- A native of Oskarshamn, Sweden, ranked tied for first in goals and power-play goals, tied for fourth in assists, fourth in points and averaged 1.03 points per game in 38 contests for the Phantoms.
- The London, Ontario native was named an alternate captain on Feb. 14



IVAN THE GREAT

- **Ivan Fedotov** stopped 22-of-23 shots in his first full 60 minutes tilt of the preseason on Saturday (9/28) against Boston.
- He made his NHL preseason debut against Washington on Sunday (9/22). He stopped 10-of-12 shots in the two periods he played before stepping aside for Carson Bjarnason.
- The goaltender enters his first full season with the Flyers after coming over in the final month of the 2023-24 NHL season.
- Last season, the 27-year-old winger led the Flyers in goals (33), shorthanded goals (6), game-winning goals (5), assists (35), points (68) and first goals of the game (7) while leading the NHL in shorthanded goals.
- His sixth shorthanded goal of the season on Apr. 13 vs. New Jersey marked his 400th career NHL point, all with Philadelphia. He became the 21st player in team history to reach the 400-point plateau
- The London, Ontario native was named an alternate captain on Feb. 14

BETWEEN THE PIPES

- **Alexsei Kolosov** set to make his 2024 Flyers preseason debut against NY Islanders on Sept. 30
 - He signed his entry-level contract with the Flyers on July 8, 2023.
 - The goaltender was Philadelphia's third-round pick (78th overall) in the 2021 NHL Draft.
- **Eetu Makiniemi** made his 2024 NHL preseason Flyers debut against Montréal on Monday. He stopped 11-of-12 shots in the half-game that he played before stepping aside for Cal Petersen.
 - The goaltender recently signed a one-year contract marking his first full season with the Flyers organization after coming over from the San Jose Sharks organization.
- **Cal Petersen** stopped 7-of-11 shots he faced in his 2024 NHL preseason debut on Monday against Montréal.
 - He enters his second season in the Flyers organization after being acquired from Los Angeles on June, 6 2023.
