- Dallas scored five goals in a game for the 20th time this season, tied for the third most among all teams behind Colorado (25) and Tampa Bay (21).
- Captain **Jamie Benn** skated in his 1,100th career NHL game (all with Dallas). There are only two players in Dallas Stars history to play 1,000 or more games with the club: **Mike Modano** (1,459) and **Jamie Benn** (1,100). Benn's goal gave him points in 11 of his past 14 games (4-11—15).
- With a goal, forward **Logan Stankoven** (6-4—10 in 12 GP) became the third-fastest player in franchise history (tied) to record 10 career NHL points. He trails only **Mike Modano** (9 GP) and **Alex Chiasson** (10 GP). His goal gave him points in two consecutive games (1-1—2).
- Defenseman **Nils Lundkvist** recorded his fifth career multi-point game with two assists (0-2—2). The 23-year-old blueliner has 17 points (2-15—17) in 47 GP.



- Forward **Tyler Seguin** (1-0—1) tallied a goal in his return to the lineup after missing 11 games with a lower-body injury. Seguin has 21 goals and 46 points (21-25—46) in 59 GP this season. It marked his 51st career game-winning goal with the Stars and trails only **Mike Modano** (92) and **Jamie Benn** (55) for the most in franchise history.
- Forward **Jason Robertson** (1-1—2) reached the 70-point mark for the third consecutive season with a goal and an assist vs. Arizona. Robertson leads the Stars this season in assists (46) and points (24-46—70) in 70 GP.
- Forward **Craig Smith** (1-0—1) extended his goal streak to three consecutive games, tying the longest goal streak of his career (last: March 3-7, 2022 w/ BOS).
