BLUE JACKETS TEAM NOTES

- ★ CBJ extended their overall points streak to five games (4-0-1) and have picked up points in six of their past five overall dating back to November 15 (5-1-1) after beating the Flames this afternoon.
- ★ CBJ ended their four-game homestead with seven points (3-0-1). It's the fourth-time in franchise history that the club has recorded at least seven points in a four-game homestand (MR: 4-0-0, Mar. 6-12, 2018).
- ★ With an 8-3-1 record and 17 points in the first 12 home games, it matches the second-most wins and points through the first 12 home games of a season in club history (eight wins in 2016-17 & 2017-18; 17 points in 2009-10 & 2016-17).
- ★ The Jackets have points in five-straight home contests (4-0-1) as well as eight of their last nine games at Nationwide Arena (7-1-1).
- ★ The club scored goals in all three periods in regulation for the fifth consecutive home game and the ninth time this season. Columbus has scored goals in 48-of-the-66 periods played in regulation this year.
- ★ With two goals in the first period, it marks the ninth time this season and sixth time at home the Blue Jackets have multiple goals in the opening frame. Columbus has posted 22 multi-goal periods this season.
- ★ The Blue Jackets have scored 77 goals through the first 22 games of the 2024-25 season (not including SO goals), the most through 22 games in club history (75, 2018-19).
- ★ CBJ scored the opening goal of the game for the 14th time this season (9-3-2) and for the seventh time in the past 10 games.
- ★ Tonight's attendance was 17,035.

BLUE JACKETS PLAYER NOTES

- ★ **C Adam Fantilli** (5-7-12, 22 GP) scored twice for his first multi-goal game of the season and the second of his career (2-1-3, Dec. 7, 2023 at NYI). The forward has points in back-to-back games (2-1-3) as well as four of his past five (2-2-4). He now has 3-1-4 in his two career home games against the Flames.

- ★ **F Kent Johnson** (5-6-11, 8 GP) scored his fifth of the season and has points in four-straight games since Nov. 21 (3-3-6). He has registered points in each contest played this season and ranks eighth in the league with 1.38 P/GP.
- ★ **RW Kirill Marchenko** (9-14-23, 22 GP) notched his second three-point game this year (1-2-3, Oct. 12 at COL) and the fourth in his NHL career, with a goal and two assists this afternoon. The forward has collected 3-4-7 in his past four games with three multi-point outings. He has posted 2-2-4 in five career contests against the Flames after today's matchup.
- ★ **D Ivan Provorov** (1-6-7, 22 GP) collected an assist on Fantilli's goal and has 0-2-2 in his last four games. The blueliner has now picked up assists in five of his last seven home games against Calgary (1-5-6).
- ★ **RW Cole Sillinger** (3-10-13, 21 GP) collected an assist and now has four assists in his last four games (0-4-4).
- ★ **LW Dmitri Voronkov** (5-5-10, 13 GP) notched his first multi-assist game this season, the second of his career (0-2-2, Dec. 8, 2023 vs. STL) and his third multi-point outing tin 2024-25. He stretched his career-high points streak to five-straight games since Nov. 18 at Boston with two multi-point contests (3-4-7).
- ★ **D Zach Werenski** (8-16-24, 22 GP) finished with 1-1-2 stretching his assists streak to seven games (5-8-13). He set a new franchise record for defensemen for assists streak as well as matched the franchise record points streak (Bryan Berard in 2005-06; Jaroslav Spacek in 2002-03; Werenski in 2019-20). Werenski is tied for the NHL lead among defensemen with eight goals this season (Makar), while also leading the club in assists and points. He now has 5-5-10 in 13 career GP, with points in four-straight games (3-1-4) against the Flames.
