PRACTICE UPDATE:

- The Stars will not practice on Sunday, Jan. 7 before their flight to Minnesota.

NOTES

- Forward **Tyler Seguin** (1-0—1) tallied his 14th goal of the season and has lit the lamp in two consecutive games (3-0—3) and in three of his past four (4-0—4).

- Captain **Jamie Benn** scored his 102nd career power-play goal. He's one of four players in franchise history with at least 100, joining **Mike Modano** (156), **Brian Bellows** (134) and **Dino Ciccarelli** (130). Benn has goals in two of his past three games (2-0—2) and 25 points (8-17—25) in 38 GP this season.

- Forward **Mason Marchment** (0-1—1) extended his point streak to four consecutive games (3-6—9). Marchment (13-17—30) has already surpassed his goal total from last season (12) and needs one point to tie his output from last season (31).

- Forward **Matt Duchene's** point streak reached four consecutive games (0-6—6) with an assist. Duchene has 15 points (5-10—15) over the past 12 games and 35 points (11-24—35) overall.

- Forward **Jason Robertson** (1-1—2) recorded his 117th career goal to surpass **Jamie Benn** (116) for the eighth most goals before age 25 in franchise history.

- Robertson also picked up his team-leading 26th assist of the season to give him 39 points (13-26—39) in 38 GP.

- Defenseman **Thomas Harley** registered two assists (0-2—2) to give him 19 points (9-10—19), second most among Stars blueliners.

- Goaltender **Scott Wedgewood** made 18 saves on 22 shots.
