AT A GLANCE

SPARKLING JUICE

Forward **Adrian Kempe** takes the ice in the Kings' final matchup of 2024 as the team's leading goal-scorer with 16 tallies through the first 35 games of the campaign. The winger enters tonight's contest with nine points (7-2=9) in 13 career games against the Flyers. Kempe has notched four goals and five points (4-1=5) in his last four home games vs. Philadelphia, a streak that started with a multi-point (1-1=2) night and a game-winning goal on New Year's Eve in 2019.

RIGHT ON Q-UEUE

Forward **Quinton Byfield** skates into Crypto.com Arena after recording his fifth career three-point game (2-1=3) yesterday afternoon against the Oilers. The performance was capped by the 22-year-old center's first career overtime goal at the 3:19 mark of the extra frame. With his trio of points yesterday, Byfield extended his point streak against Edmonton to a fifth game (4-5=9), dating back to Dec. 30, 2023. Per NHL PR, Byfield (22 years, 131 days) became the sixth player in Kings history to score an overtime goal before age 23, following **Anze Kopitar** (20 years, 78 days on Nov. 10, 2007), **Drew Doughty** (20 years, 104 days on March 22, 2010 & 22 years, 28 days on Jan. 5, 2012), **Olli Jokinen** (20 years, 115 days on March 30, 1999), **Brandt Clarke** (21 years, 8 days on Feb. 17, 2024) and **Luc Robitaille** (22 years, 359 days on Feb. 10, 1989). The forward enters the Kings' second contest against the Philadelphia Flyers in 10 days carrying a four-game point streak (1-5=6) against the club, including his first career three-point outing (0-3=3) on Nov. 4, 2023.

WAR-REN PEACE

Yesterday, forward **Warren Foegele** racked up a trio of points (1-2=3) in his first game against the Edmonton Oilers since signing with the Kings on July 1, 2024. Foegele enters tonight's rematch against the Flyers after finding the scoresheet twice (1-1=2) during the Kings' franchise-record-tying, seven-goal outing against the club on Dec. 19. With his third-period goal standing as the game-winner at Wells Fargo Center, Foegele has scored the deciding tally for the Kings in three of their ten games in December (Also Dec. 4 v. DAL and Dec. 14 at NYR) and will take the ice for the final time in 2024 tied with Anze Kopitar (4) and Alex Laferriere (4) for the most game-winning goals on the team this season.
