Signed by the Rangers as a free agent on July 1, 2023, Nick Bonino enters his 14th NHL season in 2023-24. He has collected 353 points (158G, 195A) in 823 career NHL games with the Anaheim Ducks, Vancouver Canucks, Pittsburgh Penguins, Nashville Predators, Minnesota Wild and San Jose Sharks. He's a two-time Stanley Cup Champion, winning with Pittsburgh in 2016 and 2017, and has recorded 48 points (19G, 29A) in 105 career postseason contests.
