THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

Buffalo has allowed just three power-play goals in the team's last 28 penaltykill opportunities (89.3 percent).

Tage Thompson has registered 15 points (10+5) in his last 12 home games.

Thompson has scored at least one goal in back-to-back games and a goal in tonight's game would give him his third goal streak of three or more games this season.

Alex Tuch has recorded 12 points (4+8) in his last 11 games, including one assist in each of his last two.

Dylan Cozens has tallied four points (2+2) in his last four games and he has posted six points (3+3) in his last six home contests.



Jason Zucker has tallied one assist in back-toback games.

JJ Peterka is one point away from 100 in his career.

POWER MOVE

Since the beginning of the 2022-23 season (Owen Power's first full season), only 37 NHL defensemen have recorded 65 or more even-strength points.

Among those defensemen, Power (22 years old; 67 even-strength points) is the youngest.

Since 2022-23 and among all Sabres defensemen to play a game with Buffalo in that span, he ranks tied for first in plus/minus (plus-16) and he ranks second in games played (181), goals (13), assists (70), points (83), even-strength goals (13), even-strength points, power-play points (14) and time on ice per game (23:13).

Power (22:19 time on ice per game played) is one of 12 NHL defensemen this season to record 2.50 or fewer giveaways per 60 while averaging 22 or more minutes of ice time.

Power is tied for first among all Sabres defensemen in takeaways (12) and leads all Sabres defensemen in blocked shots (41) this season.
