- Pittsburgh's Sidney Crosby and Evgeni Malkin are two of the highest scoring players in day games throughout their careers.
- Crosby's 199 points (79G-120A) are the third most in days games in NHL history, while his 79 goals are the sixth most:

Since the team has been in Winnipeg beginning in the 2011-12 season, the Penguins have gone 20-7-0 against them, outscoring the Jets by a 95-65 margin.

- Evgeni Malkin has been a leading contributer to the Penguins' success against the Jets. The forward has 20 goals, 33 assists and 53 points in 40 games against Winnipeg in his career.
- Malkin's 53 points are the sixth most against Winnipeg among all active players:
