

ARENA INFORMATION



Fifth Third Arena, Chicago Blackhawks Community Rink, is not only the practice home for the team, but also a critical community space that serves as a hub for youth hockey development programs, recreational leagues, high school teams, programming and public skate. The majority of the privately-funded, \$65 million facility's use is dedicated to the community – from ice time, use of equipment, instruction and nutritional support to after-school programming with local organizations – providing more than \$3 million of community benefits over its first five years of operation.

Originally opened in 2017, the 125,000 square-foot, state-of-the-art facility houses two regulation-sized NHL rinks, 22 team and public locker rooms, medical and rehab facilities, a public fitness training center and a media center. Additional amenities include food & beverage options (a full-service bar, concession stand, coffee & juice bar, and healthy vending options), a rooftop deck and additional space for public functions like the Great Hall and two multi-purpose rooms. The building also includes several classrooms that host Chicago Blackhawks Foundation programs for Chicago Public School students and nonprofit organizations on the importance of health, wellness, nutrition, physical fitness and STEM education.

FIFTH THIRD ARENA EXPANSION

In June 2023, the Chicago Blackhawks revealed renderings for the forthcoming Fifth Third Arena expansion – highlighting a transformative project that promises extraordinary experiences both on and off the ice. When complete in January 2026, the venue will boast more than 250,000 total square feet of community hockey space, state-of-the-art training facilities, and versatile areas for the best athletes in the world, rising stars and the next generation of players. The newly expanded Fifth Third Arena will include a 2,000 seat Championship Arena, an additional community rink, Centennial Hall, outdoor patio and a brand new "Rocky's Bar."

DIRECTIONS | 1801 W. JACKSON BLVD.

COMING FROM THE NORTH: Take 90 East to 290 West, then exit at Damen Avenue. Take Damen Avenue northbound to the first cross-street, Jackson Blvd. Make a right onto Jackson, and the building will be on your right.

COMING FROM THE SOUTH: Take 55 North to the Damen Avenue exit and make a left, going northbound for approximately three miles. Turn right onto Jackson Blvd., and the building will be on your right.

COMING FROM THE EAST: Take 290 West to the Damen Avenue exit. Take Damen Avenue northbound to Jackson Blvd. Make a right onto Jackson, and the building will be on your right.

COMING FROM THE WEST: Take 290 East to the Damen Avenue exit. Take Damen Avenue northbound to Jackson Blvd. Make a right onto Jackson, and the building will be on your right.
