- Eight different Stars skaters registered a point during the game. **Jason Robertson**, **Roope Hintz** and **Matt Duchene** each had multi-point outings.
- **Jason Robertson** (3-0—3) scored his fourth career hat trick and became the first Stars skater to score three goals in a period since **Jamie Benn** on April 7, 2018 according to NHL Stats.
 - With his three goals, Robertson surpassed J.P. Parise for 17th most goals in franchise history (156).
- **Matt Duchene** (0-2—2) tallied his fourth consecutive multi-point game and extended his point streak against the Islanders to three games (1-3—4).
- **Jake Oettinger** put up 34 saves, tying his season best (also: 34 vs. NYI).

GAME NOTES

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Tonight is the final of two games the Stars will play against the Blue Jackets this season and the only time the teams are facing off in Columbus this year. Dallas defeated Columbus 5-3 in the two teams' previous meeting on Feb. 2.
- The Stars enter tonight's game with a 37-18-2 record for 76 points and a .667 points percentage. Their win total, point total and points percentage all ranked third in the NHL this season entering play Monday.
 - Entering play Monday, six of the top eight ranked teams in points percentage in the NHL this season were in the Western Conference: Winnipeg (.728), Dallas, Vegas (.649), Edmonton (.632), Minnesota (.632) and Los Angeles (.620). The Washington Capitals (.737) topped both the NHL and the Eastern Conference, and the Toronto Maple Leafs (.632) ranked fifth.
- Since Dec. 7, the Stars have posted a 11-3-1 record on the road for 23 points and a .767 points percentage, all of which were the best marks in the NHL during that span.
- **Jamie Benn** enters tonight's game three goals shy of scoring his 400th career goal. When he reaches the milestone, he will become...
 - The second player in franchise history to score 400 goals, joining Mike Modano (557). 438 of Modano's 557 goals were scored with the Star after the team relocated to Dallas.
 - The second player drafted in 2007 to score 400 goals, with the other being Detroit's Patrick Kane (483).
 - The 10th active skater to score 400 career goals.
- Entering play Monday, the Stars and the Washington Capitals were the only NHL teams this season that have not lost more than two consecutive games.

- The Stars have allowed only 2.51 goals against per game this season, which was tied for the third-best mark in the NHL entering play Monday. Dallas has allowed two or fewer goals in 30 of the 57 games that they have played this year.

DRIVING THE 'BUS

- Dallas is 43-24-8 all-time vs. Columbus, with a 21-11-6 mark on the road.
- The Stars enter tonight's game with points in 10 of their last 12 games against the Blue Jackets (9-2-1), also earning wins in their last two games played at Nationwide Arena.
- **Matt Duchene** recorded 12 points (4-8-12) in 23 games with the Blue Jackets in 2018-19. In all, **Duchene** has recorded nine goals and 28 points (9-19-28) in 42 career games vs. Columbus. **Duchene's** first goal with Dallas came in the club's 5-3 win over Columbus on Oct. 30, 2023.
- **Jamie Benn** leads active Stars in goals (10), assists (24) and points (10-24-34) in 42 games vs. Columbus.
- **Jason Robertson** enters tonight's matchup riding a three-game point streak (1-3-4) against the Blue Jackets. **Robertson** has tallied 11 points (5-6-11) in 13 career games vs. Columbus.
- **Evgenii Dadonov** has registered four points (3-1-4) in his last three games against the Blue Jackets. In all, **Dadonov** has 11 points (7-4-11) in 18 career games vs. Columbus.
- **Wyatt Johnston** has five points (3-2-5) in five career games against the Blue Jackets.
- **Thomas Harley** has three points (1-2-3) in three career games vs. Columbus, including a multi-point outing in Dallas' last game vs. Columbus on Feb. 2 (0-2-2).
- **Mason Marchment** enters tonight's contest riding a three-game point streak against the Blue Jackets (2-1-3). In his career vs. Columbus, **Marchment** has recorded 12 points (4-8-12) in 13 games.
- **Jake Oettinger** is 9-0-1 with a 1.77 goals-against average, .927 save percentage and one shutout in 10 career appearances against the Blue Jackets. His lone shutout vs. Columbus was a 21-save performance in Dallas' 5-0 victory on March 6, 2021.

NEW YEAR, NEW ME

- Since Jan. 1, **Matt Duchene**, **Jason Robertsson** and **Wyatt Johnston** are all ranked in the top 10 in the NHL in scoring. With 26 points each, **Duchene** (9-17-26) and **Robertson** (14-12-26) were tied for fourth entering play Monday and **Johnston** (8-17-25) was tied for eighth.
- Entering play Monday, the Stars were the only team to have three players ranked in the top 10 in league scoring since the New Year. Detroit (Lucas Raymond and Dylan Larkin) was the only other team with multiple players ranked within the top 10.
- **Robertson's** 14 goals ranked third in the NHL since the start of the New Year entering play Monday.
- **Thoams Harley** has scored six goals since Jan. 1, which was tied for fourth among all NHL defensemen entering play Monday.

POWER UP

- The Stars enter tonight's game having scored at least one power-play goal in each of their last three games played. If they were to do so again tonight, it would give them power-play goals in three consecutive games for the first time this season.
- Since Jan. 11, the Stars have gone 17-for-52 on the power play for a 32.7 percent success rate, which ranked third in the NHL during that span entering play Monday.
- The team's 17 power-play goals since Jan. 1 were the second-most in the NHL entering play Monday, trailing only the Detroit Red Wings (24) for the league lead.
- Five of those 17 goals have been scored by **Jason Robertson**. Since Jan. 1, only Detroit's Dylan Larkin (7) had scored more power-play goals than **Robertson** entering play Monday.

DOUBLE DUTCH

- **Matt Duchene** has recorded multi-point efforts in each of Dallas' last four games, scoring two goals and adding an assist on Feb. 7 against the Kings and again on Feb. 8 against the Sharks, scoring the game-winning goal and notching an assist on Feb. 22 against the Devils, and then tallying two assists on Feb. 23 against the Islanders.
- If **Duchene** were to have at least two points again tonight, it would mark the first time in Stars team history that a skater has recorded multi-point efforts in five consecutive games according to NHL Stats.
 - There have been nine previous instances of a player having five consecutive multi-point games in franchise history, all when the team was located in Minnesota.
 - The most recent instance of a Stars/North Stars player having at least five consecutive multi-point games was when Dino Ciccarelli had six straight multi-point games from Feb. 24 to March 7, 1987.
- A multi-point effort tonight would also give **Duchene** five consecutive multi-point games for the first time in his career.
- **Duchene's** performance against the Islanders brought his season point total up to 59 (23-36-59), which leads all Stars skaters. It puts him on pace to finish the season with 33 goals, 52 assists and 85 points. Fifty-two assists would be a career high, and 33 goals and 85 points would both be the second-best marks of his career.
 - If he were to finish the year with at least 85 points, it would make him the highest-scoring Star since **Jason Robertson** had 109 points in 2022-23. It would also make him the third Stars skater in the last 10 years to have at least 85 points in a season, joining **Robertson** and **Jamie Benn** in 2014-15 (87) and 2015-16 (89).

- The 2024-25 season is already tied for the sixth-highest scoring season of **Duchene's** career, and he is one point shy of recording his sixth 60-point season.

JOHNNY B. GOODE

- **Wyatt Johnston** notched an assist in Dallas' last game – a 4-3 win over the Islanders – and enters tonight's matchup riding a three-game point streak.
- **Johnston's** assist was his 33rd of the season, matching his career high that he set last year. His assist was also the 83rd of his career, which tied Buffalo's Owen Power for the most by a player selected in the 2021 NHL Draft.
 - **Johnston's** 73 career goals and 156 career points are both the most of any player from the 2021 Draft class.
- **Johnston** now has 50 points (17-33—50) in 57 games this season, which ranks third on the Stars in scoring and makes the 2024-25 season his second-consecutive 50-point season.
- He's now on pace to finish the year with 72 points, which would be a career high for the forward.
- **Johnston's** scored his third shorthanded goal of the season in Dallas' Feb. 22 game against the New Jersey Devils. Entering play Monday, his three shorthanded goals were tied for third in the NHL this year.
- The goal was also the sixth shorthanded tally of his career. Since **Johnston** made his NHL debut, his six shorthanded goals rank second on Dallas' roster (**Roope Hintz**; 7) and are tied for eighth in the NHL.
- **Johnston** has been playing at a point-per-game pace since Nov. 10, totaling 44 points (16-28—44) in 44 games played.

BIKER GANG

- **Thomas Harley** has tallied seven points (3-4—7) in his last seven games dating back to Jan. 31 against the Vancouver Canucks. His seven points during that span rank fourth on Dallas' roster.
- **Harley's** seven points since Jan. 31 were also tied for the third-most among all NHL defensemen during that span entering play Monday, trailing only Buffalo's Rasmus Dahlin (11) and Colorado's Cale Makar (8).
- When **Harley** had been on the ice during even-strength play this season, the Stars have outscored their opponents 66-35. Entering play Monday, his plus-31 goal differential was tied for the second-best mark among all NHL skaters this year and his 65 goals for were tied for seventh.
 - Additionally, **Harley** has logged a plus-29 plus/minus rating this season, which ranked seventh in the NHL and ranked fourth among all NHL defensemen entering play Monday.
- In all, **Harley** has totaled 30 points (10-20—30) in 55 regular-season games this season, which would put him on pace to finish the 2024-25 regular season with 15 goals, 29 assists and 44 points. Fifteen goals would set a career high for the defenseman, and 29 assists and 44 points would both be the second-highest totals of his career.
 - His 10 goals this season were tied for the sixth-most among all NHL defensemen this season entering play Monday.

DALLAS MAVRIK

- **Mavrik Bourque** enters tonight's game riding a five-game point streak dating back to Feb. 2 against the Columbus Blue Jackets. A goal or an assist tonight would give him points in six consecutive games for the first time in his career.
 - Only two other rookies this season have had a point streak of at least six games: Montreal's Lane Hutson (2x) and San Jose's Will Smith.
- If **Bourque** were to extend his point streak tonight, he would also become the first Stars rookie to have a point in at least six consecutive games since **Jason Robertson** had a point in nine straight games from April 14 to 27, 2021.
- **Bourque** has notched an assist in each of Dallas' last two games. If he were to do so again tonight, it would give him assists in three consecutive games for the first time in his career.
- Since Jan. 1, **Bourque** has scored six goals – including the Stars fifth of the game in their game on Feb. 8 against the San Jose Sharks. His six goals during that span were tied for the second-most among all NHL rookies entering play Monday, trailing only Detroit's Marco Kasper (8).
 - **Bourque's** six goals since Jan. 1 are tied for fourth on Dallas' roster.
- Since Jan. 1, the Stars have outscored their opponents 11-8 when **Bourque** has been on the ice during even-strength play.
- In all, **Bourque** has totaled 11 points (6-5—11) since Jan. 1, which is four points better than the seven he had from the start of the regular season through Dec. 31. His 11 points since Jan. 1 were tied for fourth among all NHL rookies entering play Monday.
- Entering play Monday, **Bourque** was ranked in the top 10 this season in rookie goals (eight, tied eighth) and rookie points (18, tied 10th).
 - Fellow rookie **Logan Stankoven** (7-18—25) was tied for fourth in rookie scoring entering play Monday.

KILLING IT

- The Stars have had an 85 percent success rate on the penalty kill this season, which was tied with Carolina for the best mark in the NHL this year entering play Monday.
- No team in the league this season has allowed fewer power-play goals against than the Stars' 23, and their -18 goal differential on the penalty kill this year was also tied for the second-best mark in the NHL entering play Monday.
- If the Stars maintain this pace, it would make the 2024-25 season their best on the penalty kill since 2007-08, when the team finished the season with an 85.6 percent success rate on the penalty kill.

- The Stars are also one of the least-penalized teams in the league, ranking 27th in the league in both total penalty minutes (388) and penalty minutes per game (6:48) entering play Monday.
- Entering play Monday, **Esa Lindell** was leading all NHL skaters in total shorthanded ice time (198:31) and ranked third in shorthanded ice time per game (3:29) this season.
- **Sam Steel** ranked fourth in the NHL entering play Monday in power-play goals against per 60 (4.13) among players to have played at least 100 minutes on the penalty kill this season.
 - **Steel** has totaled 104:04 of shorthanded ice time and is averaging 1:54 of shorthanded ice time per game, both of which top all Dallas forwards this season.
- Among players that have played at least 50 minutes on the penalty kill this season, **Thomas Harley** (who has totaled 99:53 of shorthanded ice time) ranked ninth in the NHL in power-play goals against per 60 with 3.60 entering play Monday.

BISCH BETTER HAVE MY MONEY

- Stars rookie **Lian Bichsel** has played in all 10 of Dallas' games since being recalled from Texas (AHL) on Jan. 23. In those games, the Stars have outscored their opponents 12-8 during even-strength play when **Bichsel** has been on the ice.
 - Only **Thomas Harley** (13) has been on the ice for more even-strength goals for than **Bichsel** since Jan. 23.
 - **Bichsel's** plus-4 on-ice even-strength goal differential during that span is tied for the fourth-best mark on Dallas' roster.
- Additionally, since Jan. 1 during 5-on-5 play, the Stars have outshot their opponents 75-56 and had 72 scoring chances to their 61 when **Bichsel** has been on the ice according to Natural Stat Trick.
 - His 57.3 shots for percentage tops all Stars skaters during that span.
- **Bichsel** had two assists in Dallas' game on Feb. 8, an 8-3 win over the San Jose Sharks. It marked both the first multi-point performance of his career and the first time that he has recorded a point in a road game.
- **Bichsel's** assists brought his season point total up to five (2-3-5), which tied him for fifth in scoring among rookie defensemen this season entering play Monday. He is also averaging 0.28 points per game this year, which ranked sixth among rookie defensemen.
- **Bichsel** has recorded at least four hits in eight of the 10 games that he has played since being recalled from Texas (AHL). In all this season, he is averaging 16.2 hits per 60, which tops the Stars roster and ranked eighth among all NHL rookies this season to play in at least five games entering play Monday.
- Despite only playing in 18 games this season, **Bichsel** ranks second on the Stars roster with 73 hits. His 73 hits were also tied for 10th among all NHL rookies this season entering play Monday.
- There have been six instances of a Stars skater recording six hits in a single game this season, with **Bichsel** owning five of them.

HEATING UP

- **Jake Oettinger** has an 11-3-1 record in his last 15 games played dating back to Dec. 29, posting a .918 save percentage and a 2.25 goals-against average during that span.
 - His 11 wins since Dec. 29 were tied for the most in the NHL entering play Monday.
- **Mikael Granlund** has 12 points (3-9-12) in his last 12 games played, including tallying four assists in his first six games as a member of the Stars.
- **Roope Hintz** has 11 points (3-6-9) in his last 10 games dating back to Jan. 24.

BACK TO DECEMBER

- Since Dec. 23, the Stars have posted an 18-5-2 record for 38 points and a .760 points percentage. Dallas' win and point total were both the best marks in the league during that span entering play Monday, and their points percentage ranked second (Winnipeg; .773).
- During that span, the Stars have outscored their opponents 87-60. No team had scored more goals than the Stars since Dec. 23 entering play Monday.
- The team's plus-27 goal differential was tied with Winnipeg for the second-best mark in the league since Dec. 23 entering play Monday, trailing only the Washington Capitals (plus-29).
- Sixty-one of Dallas' 87 goals since Dec. 23 have been scored at 5-on-5, which was tied with the Buffalo Sabres for the best mark in the NHL during that span entering play Monday.
- **Jason Robertson** is the team's leading scorer since Dec. 23, totaling 32 points (16-16-32) in 25 games played. His 32 points during that span ranked fourth in the NHL entering play Monday.
 - His 16 goals during that span were tied for the second-most in the NHL entering play Monday.

IRON SHARPENS IRON

- The Stars have four skaters that have played in at least 200 consecutive games: **Jamie Benn** (354), **Jason Robertson** (267), **Esa Lindell** (227) and **Wyatt Johnston** (221). Entering play Monday, Dallas was the only team in the NHL to have four players riding Iron Man streaks of at least 200 games.
- Dallas' last game on Feb. 23 against the Islanders was the 354th consecutive game that **Benn** played in, which is the fifth-longest active Iron Man streak in the NHL.

- **Robertson's** 267-game Iron Man streak is the 13th-longest in the NHL. The Stars and the Detroit Red Wings were the only teams to have two players ranked in the top 15 entering play Monday.
- **Lindell's** 227-game Iron Man streak ranks eighth among all NHL defensemen.
- **Johnston's** Iron Man Streak began when he made his NHL debut on Oct. 13, 2022. He is one of 44 players in NHL history to begin their NHL career by playing in at least 200 consecutive games according to NHL Stats.

ONE FOR THE HISTORY BOOKS

- **Jake Oettinger's** next shutout will be the 12th of his career, which will tie Jon Casey for the sixth-most in franchise history.
- **Jake Oettinger** is one win away from tying Gilles Meloche (141) for 5th most wins by a goaltender in franchise history.
- **Thomas Harley** is 14 assists shy of tying Gary Sargen (71) for 25th among all-time defensemen.
- **Jason Robertson** is six points shy of tying John Klingberg (374) for 18th-most points in franchise history.
- **Roope Hintz** is nine points shy of tying Loui Eriksson (357) for 20th-most points in franchise history.
- **Roope Hintz** is seven goals shy of tying Danny Grant (176) for 15th-most goals in franchise history.
- **Esa Lindell** is eight assists shy of tying Stephane Robidas (165) for 10th-most assists by a defenseman in franchise history.

CONNECT FOUR

- Five Stars players represented their home country at the recently completed 4 Nations Face-Off: **Mikael Granlund** (Finland), **Thomas Harley** (Canada), **Roope Hintz** (Finland), **Esa Lindell** (Finland) and **Jake Oettinger** (United States). Dallas defenseman **Miro Heiskanen** was originally selected to Finland's roster but had to withdraw from the tournament due to injury.
- The Stars were also well-represented among the 4 Nations staff, with **Jim Nill** (Associate GM), **Pete DeBoer** (Assistant Coach) and **Misha Donskov** (Assistant Coach) all joining Canada's staff for the tournament. Additionally, former Star **Jere Lehtinen** served as Finland's General Manager.
- **Harley, Nill, DeBoer** and **Donskov** won the 4 Nations Face-Off Championship after Canada defeated the United States 3-2 in overtime on Feb. 20.
- **Harley**, who was originally added to Canada's roster as an injury replacement, appeared in two games for his home country, both against the United States. He tallied one assist and averaged 20:07 of ice time per game.
- When **Harley** was on the ice during 5-on-5 play in the two games he played, the Canadians outshot the Americans 17-11. His plus-6 on-ice shot differential was the best mark of any Canadian defenseman in those two games.
- **Granlund** finished the tournament with four points (3-1-4) in three games for the Finns. His three goals were tied for the second-most among all skaters and his four points tied for fourth.
- **Lindell** and **Hintz** each appeared in three games for Finland, with **Lindell** scoring one goal.
- The 4 Nations Face-Off marked the first time that **Granlund, Hintz** and **Lindell** played for Finland together. **Granlund** and **Lindell** had previously represented Finland together three times: at the 2016 and 2022 IIHF World Championships and at the 2016 World Cup of Hockey.
- **Oettinger** started one game for the Americans, stopping 21 of the 23 shots he faced for a .913 save percentage and a 2.06 goals-against average.

CONNECTIONS

- Stars forward **Matt Duchene** played for the Columbus Blue Jackets following the trade deadline during the 2018-19 season. With Columbus, Duchene registered 12 points (4-8-12) in 23 games played.
- Blue Jackets head coach Dean Evason played for the Dallas Stars during the 1993-94 and 1994-95 seasons.
- Stars coaches **Pete DeBoer** and **Steve Spott** coached Blue Jackets forward Kevin Labanc in San Jose from 2016-17 until 2019-20.
- Stars assistant coach **Steve Spott** coached Blue Jackets forward James van Riemsdyk in Toronto during the 2014-15 season.
- Stars goaltender **Casey DeSmith** and Blue Jackets forward Zach Aston-Reese both played in Pittsburgh from 2017-18 to 2021-22.
- Stars forward **Sam Steel** and Blue Jackets forward Zach Aston-Reese shared the ice in Anaheim during the 2021-22 season.
- Stars Player Development Assistant **Jordie Benn** and Blue Jackets forward Zach Aston-Reese skated together in Toronto during the 2022-23 season.
- Stars forward **Evgenii Dadonov** and Blue Jackets forward Sean Monahan and defenseman Jordan Harris were teammates in Montréal during the 2022-23 season.
- Stars forwards **Colin Blackwell, Matt Duchene** and **Mikael Granlund** skated with Blue Jackets forward Mathieu Olivier and defensemen Dante Fabbro in Nashville during the 2019-20 season. Duchene, Granlund, Olivier and Fabbro also played in Nashville for the 2020-21 and 2021-22 seasons.
- Stars forward **Evgenii Dadonov** and Blue Jackets defenseman Erik Gudbranson played together for the Florida Panthers during the 2011-12 season.
- Stars VP of Cultural Growth & Strategy **Al Montoya** and Blue Jackets defenseman Erik Gudbranson played together with the Florida Panthers from 2014-15 until 2015-16.

- Stars goaltender **Casey DeSmith** and Blue Jackets defenseman Erik Gudbranson shared the ice in Pittsburgh for the 2018-19 and 2019-20 seasons.
- Stars forward **Sam Steel** and Blue Jackets defenseman Erik Gudbranson were teammates in Anaheim during the 2019-20 season.
- Stars goaltender **Casey DeSmith** and Blue Jackets defenseman Jack Johnson played together in Pittsburgh from 2018-19 to 2019-20.
- Stars defenseman **Brendan Smith** and Blue Jackets defenseman Jack Johnson were both members of the New York Rangers during the 2020-21 season.
- Stars forward **Colin Blackwell** and Blue Jackets defenseman Jack Johnson were teammates in Chicago during the 2022-23 season.
- Stars defenseman **Brendan Smith** and Blue Jackets defenseman Damon Severson skated together in New Jersey during the 2022-23 season.
- Stars forward **Sam Steel**, defenseman **Matt Dumba** and Player Development Assistant **Jordie Benn** played under Blue Jackets head coach Dean Evason when they played for the Minnesota Wild. Steel and Dumba from 2018-19 to 2022-23 and Jordie Benn in 2021-22.
