TOP NOTES

The Sabres have now earned five consecutive home wins against the Hurricanes. It is tied for the longest home winning streak against Carolina in franchise history and the Sabres last did so from Oct. 20, 2006 to Jan. 17, 2009.

With his goal, Alex Tuch has now recorded seven points (2+5) in his last six games. The goal made **Tuch** the first Sabres skater since Randy Burridge from Oct. 26, 1996 to Jan. 25, 1997 (five games; 3+3) to record a point streak of five or more games against the Hurricanes.

Tuch has recorded at least one point in each of his last five games against the Hurricanes and he has registered six points (4+2) in that span.

Ryan McLeod notched the primary assist on Tuch's goal. As a result, McLeod extended his point streak against the Hurricanes to seven games and he has posted nine points (4+5) in those games. He has now recorded at least one point in all five of his games against Carolina since joining the Sabres, totaling seven points (3+4).

Josh Doan's assist on Tuch's goal gave him six points (3+3) in his last six games.

Jack Quinn's goal gave him three points (2+1) in his last two games, including one goal in each of those games. It marked the seventh time he has registered a goal in back-to-back games in his career.

McLeod's assist on Quinn's goal gave him two points (1+1) in today's game. It marked the second time in his career that he has tallied multiple points in two or more consecutive games since he did so from Dec. 21 to 28, 2023 (3 games; 4+2).

Jason Zucker also recorded an assist on Quinn's goal. His assist extended his current personal point streak to three games. He has registered five points (1+4) in that span.

Beck Malenstyn's goal gave him one point in back-to-back games (1+1). It marked the first time he has posted one or more points in consecutive games since he did so from Dec. 7 to 9, 2024 (0+2).

Tage Thompson's goal gave him the longest goal streak of his career (6 games) and made him the first Sabres skater to register a goal streak of six or more games since Jason Pominville (6 games; Oct. 20 to Nov. 2, 2006). Thompson has tallied nine points (6+3) during the streak.
