- Forward **Tyler Seguin** (2-0—2) scored his fourth and fifth career goals in the Conference Finals, lighting the lamp for the first time in the round before the Stanley Cup Final since Game 2 of the 2011 Eastern Conference Final with Boston. He became the seventh player in NHL history to score a goal in the Conference Finals/Semifinals as a teenager and at age 30 or older, following **Dainius Zubrus** (1997 to 2016), **Brendan Shanahan** (1988 to 2002), **Eric Desjardins** (1989 to 2000), **Bryan Trottier** (1976 to 1992), **Ted Lindsay** (1945 to 1965) and **Hec Kilrea** (1927 to 1939).
- In the 2024 playoffs, Seguin has five goals and 10 points (5-5—10) in 14 GP.
- Forward **Jason Robertson** (0-1—1) tallied his team-leading 10th assist of the playoffs. Robertson has points in six of his past seven games (0-8—8) and 13 points (3-10—13) in 14 GP.
- Captain **Jamie Benn** (0-1—1) recorded his sixth assist of the postseason. Benn has points in two consecutive games (1-1—2) and nine points (3-6—9) in 14 GP.
- Forward **Evgenii Dadonov** (0-1—1) earned his fourth assist of the playoffs to give him seven points (3-4—7) in 14 GP.
- Goaltender **Jake Oettinger** played in his 42nd career playoff game and passed **Jon Casey** (41 GP) for sole possession of fourth on the franchise's all-time list. He trails only **Ed Belfour** (73 GP), **Marty Turco** (47 GP) and **Gilles Meloche** (45 GP).
