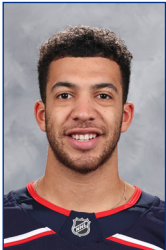

TOP NOTES

The Sabres have earned at least one point in six of their last seven games (4-1-2).

Josh Doan scored Buffalo's first goal on the night and he has posted seven points (3+4) in his last seven games.

Alex Tuch registered the primary assist on **Doan's** goal and he has recorded nine points (3+6) in his last eight games, including at least one point in each of his last six home games (3+6).

Tuch also notched an assist on **Ryan McLeod's** goal and he has recorded 13 points (5+8) in his last 11 games against Columbus, all of which have come with Buffalo.

With his first assist, **Tuch** matched his longest home point streak as a member of the Sabres (Dec. 29, 2021 to Feb. 15, 2022; 3+5).

Following his goal in tonight's game, **McLeod** has now collected seven points (3+4) in his last seven games, including at least one point in four straight contests (1+4).

Bowen Byram's assist on **McLeod's** goal gave him six points (3+3) in four home games against the Blue Jackets in his career.

Josh Dunne's goal marked the first of his NHL career. **Dunne** (26 years, 324 days) became the oldest Sabres skater since Ethan Prow (29 years, 42 days) on Dec. 29, 2021 to record the first goal of their NHL career with Buffalo. He is the fifth-oldest Sabres skater in franchise history to do so.

Mattias Samuelsson assisted on **Dunne's** goal and he has now registered five points (2+3) in his last four games.

Samuelsson's assist gave him the longest point streak of his career (four games).

Tonight's game marked **Michael Kesselring's** Buffalo Sabres debut. **Kesselring** skated 17:58 and registered nine shot attempts and a plus-1 rating.

Alex Lyon recorded 36 saves in tonight's game and has made 251 saves in his first eight games with Buffalo, the most by a goaltender in their first eight games with the Sabres since **Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen** from April 4 to Dec. 14, 2021 (259 saves).
