
## **MILESTONE MALKIN**

Evgeni Malkin, who has already hit the 800-assist and 1,300-point plateaus in the first four games this season, enters tonight's game one goal away from becoming the fourth active player and 48th player in NHL history to score 500 career goals.

Malkin is set to join Mario Lemieux and teammate Sidney Crosby as the only Penguins to score 500 career goals. The Penguins will become just the second team in NHL history to have three 500-goal scorers:

#### **BANG BANG KRIS LETANG**

Kris Letang scored in his second-consecutive game on Monday night in his hometown Montreal, marking his first two-game goal streak since Feb. 22-25.

- With a goal tonight, Letang will have just the third three-goal streak of his career, with the most recent occuring from Nov. 27-30, 2019.
- In 50 career games against the Sabres, Letang has tallied six goals, 27 assists and 33 points. His 27 assists are the most against the Sabres among active defensemen, while his 33 points are second only to teammate Erik Karlsson:

# **CAPTAIN CROSBY**

After recording three points (3A) in his first four games of the season, Sidney Crosby enters tonight's game one point away from hitting the 1,600-point milestone.

Crosby, who is entering his 1,277th career game tonight, is looking to become the fifth-fastest player to record 1,600 points:

Crosby enters tonight's game ranking 10th on the NHL's all-time points list. He has the opportunity to crack into the NHL's top-10 assists list with 43 more assists this season and needs eight tallies to become the second active player with 600 career goals.

### MULTI-POINT MALKIN

Evgeni Malkin has been red hot to start the season as he has recorded three-consecutive multi-point games entering tonight's game, recording a total of seven points [1G-6A].

- Malkin, who is tied for the league lead in points so far this season (7), is also tied with Winnipeg's Mark Scheifele, St. Louis' Jordan Kyrou and NY Rangers' Artemi Panarin for the league lead in multi-point games with three.
- With multiple points again tonight, Malkin will record a four-game point streak for just the fifth time in his career, and first since 2013-14:

Entering tonight's game against Buffalo, Malkin has 69 points [21G-48A] in 53 career games against the Sabres. He has 22 multi-point games versus Buffalo and has only been held scoreless twice in his last 23 matchups against them.
