TOP NOTES

With his shutout in tonight's game, **Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen** became the ninth Sabres goaltender, and the first since Carter Hutton from Oct. 14 to 17, 2019, to record a shutout in two or more consecutive starts. His current shutout sequence of 157:55 is the second-longest in the NHL this season and the ninth-longest in Sabres history.

In his last six games, **Luukkonen** is 5-1-0 with a 1.17 goals-against average and a .956 save percentage.

The Sabres have now earned at least one point in seven straight games against Chicago, which marks the team's longest point streak against the Blackhawks since they earned at least one point in six consecutive games from Oct. 19, 1977 to Jan. 4, 1979 (4–0–2).

Zemgus Girgensons' goal was his fourth of the season and his second in his last six games. He also recorded a goal on Jan. 6 at Pittsburgh. It marked the second time he has scored against the Blackhawks in his career (Oct. 11, 2014 on Corey Crawford).

Ryan Johnson recorded the primary assist on Girgensons' goal, which marked the first time he has recorded an assist in consecutive games in his career. **Johnson** recorded his second assist of tonight's game on **JJ Peterka's** goal, which gave him the first multi-point game of his NHL career.

Jack Quinn's assist on **Peterka's** goal gave him an assist in consecutive games. It marked the seventh time in his career, and the first time this season, that he has registered at least one assist in two or more consecutive games.

With his goal, **Rasmus Dahlin** has now recorded seven points (3+4) in his last seven games. **Dahlin** has tallied seven points (2+5) in his last six games against Chicago.

With his assist on **Dahlin's** goal, **Casey Mittelstadt** is now riding a six-game point streak (1+5) against the Blackhawks. His assist makes him the first Sabres skater since Dave Andreychuk (seven games; 2+8) from Nov. 1, 1987 to Jan. 26, 1990 to record a point streak of six or more games against Chicago.

Alex Tuch also notched an assist on **Dahlin's** goal and has now recorded seven points (3+4) in his last seven games. In his last 11 games against Chicago, **Tuch** has recorded 11 points (4+7).
