## **NOTES**

- Captain **Jamie Benn** (1-0—1) tallied his 24th career postseason goal to get the Stars on the board at the 16:07 mark of the first period. Benn needs one goal to tie **Joe Pavelski** (25) for eighth on the franchise's all-time list for playoff goals. (**Joe Nieuwendyk** also has 25).
- Forward **Jason Robertson** scored his ninth career playoff goal with 1:31 remaining in the opening frame. Robertson had seven goals and 18 points (7-11—18) in 19 postseason games in 2023.
- Forward **Mason Marchment** (1-0—1) scored his seventh career postseason goal in the third period. Marchment set career highs in goals (22), assists (31) and points (22-31—53) in 81 games during the 2023-24 regular season.
- Making his Stanley Cup Playoff debut, rookie forward **Logan Stankoven** (0-1—1) picked up the lone assist on Robertson's goal. Stankoven had 14 points (6-8—14) in 24 regular-season games.
- Defenseman **Miro Heiskanen** picked up his first point of the 2023 playoffs with an assist (0-1—1). Heiskanen has 45 points (10-35—45) in 66 career playoff games, all with Dallas.
- Goaltender **Jake Oettinger** made 11 saves on 15 shots in the loss. He registered his first career postseason point with an assist on Marchment's goal in the third period. The 25-year-old netminder is 13-13 with a 2.64 goals-against average and .917 save percentage in 28 career playoff appearances.
