PLAYER NOTES

- **Fraser Minten** scored the game-winning goal for the Maple Leafs at 8:53 of the first period. With the goal, Minten scored the first goal of his NHL career.
- **William Nylander** scored on a Maple Leafs power play opportunity at 3:01 of the third period, posting his 13th goal of the season. Nylander scored the 230th goal of his NHL career, tying with Ted Kennedy for 11th on the franchise all-time list for most goals. Nylander also registered the primary assist on Minten’s goal, recording his ninth assist of the season. Nylander marked his ninth multi-point game of the season. Per NHL Stats, “Nylander recorded his 141st career multi-point game to pass Kennedy (140) and tie Ron Ellis for the 10th most in club history.” Nylander has posted four points (2G, 2A) in his last three games.
- **Pontus Holmberg** capitalized on the Golden Knights’ empty net at 16:41 of the third period, scoring his first goal of the season. Holmberg has recorded two points in his last three games (1G, 1A).
- **Oliver Ekman-Larsson** registered the secondary assist on Minten’s goal, posting his seventh assist of the season. Ekman-Larsson has recorded an assist in back-to-back games.
- **Mitch Marner** posted the primary assist on Nylander’s power play goal and the primary assist on Holmberg’s goal. Marner became the first Maple Leaf to reach 20 assists this season, currently tying for the fourth most assists in the league. Marner marked his fifth multi-assist game of the season and his 10th multi-point game of the season. Marner has recorded an assist in three-consecutive games recording six points during his assist streak (2G, 4A).
- **John Tavares** recorded the secondary assist on Nylander’s power play goal and the secondary assist on Holmberg’s goal. Tavares marked his second multi-assist game of the season and his fifth multi-point game of the season. Tavares has recorded an assist in three-consecutive games recording five points during his assist streak (1G, 4A).
- **Nikita Grebenkin** skated in his NHL debut tonight with the Maple Leafs and posted one shot, one block and four hits in 11:05 of ice time.
- **Simon Benoit** registered eight hits tonight, a single-game high this season.
- **Joseph Woll** stopped all 31 shots he faced in tonight’s win. Woll earned the second shutout of his NHL career. With the 25th win of his NHL career tonight, “Woll (42 GP) required the second-fewest appearances in franchise history to reach 25 NHL wins behind Al Rollins (40 GP from 1949-50 to 1950-51),” per NHL Stats.
- **Simon Benoit** and **Conor Timmins** were on the ice for a team-high 22 Toronto shot attempts-for at 5-on-5.
- **Nikita Grebenkin** finished the game with a team-high 5-on-5 shot attempt percentage of 65.00 percent (13 for, 7 against).

TEAM NOTES

- The Maple Leafs were 1-for-2 on the power play and 3-for-3 on the penalty kill tonight.
- Toronto has posted a 9-3-0 record on home ice this season and are currently tied with Winnipeg for the league-lead in home wins with nine.
- The Maple Leafs have captured a win in three-consecutive games while earning a point in 10 of their last 12 matchups (8-2-2).
