TOP NOTES

With tonight's win, **Lindy Ruff** became just the second head coach in NHL history to win 600 or more regular-season games with a single franchise. Only Al Arbour (740 regular season wins with the New York Islanders) has won more games with one team.

Buffalo has won four of its last five games against Ottawa overall and it has earned a win in five of its last six home contests against the Senators.

The Sabres have earned the third-most home wins against the Senators alltime (44), trailing just the Bruins (50) and the Canadiens (47) in that category.

Jack Quinn's goal gave him three goals in his last two games against the Senators.

JJ Peterka registered an assist on **Quinn's** goal and he has registered 20 points (7+13) in his last 17 home games, including six points (2+4) in his last six home contests.

Ryan McLeod also notched an assist on **Quinn's** goal. In his last 10 games, **McLeod** has posted 12 points (3+9), including one point in three straight home games (1+2).

Jacob Bernard-Docker's goal was his first as a member of the Sabres. It gave him three points (1+2) in his last two games.

Tyson Kozak's assist on **Bernard-Docker's** goal marked the first assist of his NHL career.

With his goal, **Tage Thompson** became just the third Sabres skater to record 30 or more even-strength goals in a single season since 1993 (Jason Pominville, 2006-07, 30 EVG; Jeff Skinner, 2018-19, 32 EVG). **Thompson** has posted 36 points (18+18) in his last 35 games, including 21 points (13+8) in his last 20.

With his assist on **Thompson's** goal, **Rasmus Dahlin** has registered one point in three consecutive games and his point tonight gave him his seventh point streak of three or more games this season (1+2).

Dahlin has registered eight assists in his last eight games against the Senators, including six assists in his last five home contests against Ottawa.
