THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The Sabres have earned a win in five of their last six games.

Buffalo has registered 32 goals in its last six games (5.33 goals per game) and a five-goal performance tonight would mark the highest goal total the Sabres have had in any seven-game span since they recorded 38 goals from Oct. 14 to 28, 2006.

The Sabres have earned at least one point in six of their last eight meetings with the Lightning (5-2-1).

In his last 14 games, **Ryan McLeod** has posted 17 points (5+12) and has recorded at least one point in three straight games.

JJ Peterka has tallied 28 points (13+15) in his last 25 games and he has registered 16 points (6+10) in his last 14 games.



Tage Thompson has posted 41 points (23+18) in his last 39 games, including six points (5+1) in his last six games.

Peyton Krebs is riding a career-best five-game point streak and he has tallied six points (3+3) in that span.

Jack Quinn has recorded at least one point in five consecutive games and he

has tallied nine points (4+5) in that span.

In his last six games, **Alex Tuch** has posted nine points (6+3), including at least one point in four straight games.

Tuch has recorded at least one goal in four straight games and a goal tonight would mark the longest goal streak of his career.

LNOAH'S ARG

Buffalo recalled forward **Noah Ostlund** from the Rochester Americans (AHL) yesterday.

Prior to being recalled, **Ostlund** was riding a six-game goal streak with the Amerks and he had registered eight goals in that span.

Ostlund had registered at least one point with Rochester in eight consecutive games leading up to his recall and he had posted 13 points (8+5) in that span.

Ostlund ranks first among all Amerks rookie skaters in goals (19), points (36), points per game (0.82) and plus/minus (plus-20) this season.

Ostlund notched 14 points (9+5) in 11 games with Rochester in the month of March and was named the AHL Rookie of the Month on April 1.

He was named AHL Player of the Week for the period ending March 30 after recording six points (3+3) in three games in that span.
