THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Tonight's game against Chicago will mark the only time this season that the Stars will face the same opponent in consecutive games at the American Airlines Center. They most recently defeated the Blackhawks 4-2 on Oct. 26 at the ΔΔC
- Tonight is the third game that the Stars will play against a Central Division opponent this season, having gone 2-0-0 in their previous two games (Oct. 10 at Nashville and Oct. 26 vs. Chicago).
- The Stars have posted a 10-2-0 record against the Blackhawks since the 2021-22 season, outscoring Chicago 50-29 in those games.
 - o No team has scored more goals against the Blackhawks than the Stars since the start of the 2021-22 season.
 - o The team's 20 points against Chicago since 2021-22 were fourth-most of any NHL team.
- The Stars have allowed only 2.45 goals against per game this season, which was tied for the third-best mark in the NHL
 in the NHL entering play Wednesday.
- The Stars have gone 31-for-34 on the penalty kill this season for an 88.6 percent success rate, which was the fourth-best mark in the league entering play Wednesday.
- Esa Lindell is averaging 3:43 of shorthanded time on ice per game this season, which was the eighth-highest mark in the NHL entering play Wednesday.
- Stars head coach Pete DeBoer is one win away from tying Bryan Murray (620) for 20th on the all-time head coaching
 wins list.

BLACKHAWK DOWN

- Jamie Benn has 18 points (7-11—18) in his last 18 games against Chicago dating back to March 9, 2021.
- Evgenii Dadonov has recorded a point in five of the six games he has played against Chicago as a member of the Dallas Stars, scoring one goal and adding five assists in those games.
- Matt Duchene has five points (3-2—5) in his last four games against Chicago.
- Miro Heiskanen has 15 points (2-13—15) in his last 14 games against Chicago dating back to April 8, 2021.

- o Since the start of the 2020-21 season, **Heiskanen** has recorded 16 points (2-14—16) in 19 games against the Blackhawks, which is tied for the second-highest total of any NHL defensemen during that span.
- o In all, **Heiskanen** has 17 career points (2-15—17) in 26 career games against Chicago, which is his highest total against a single opponent.
- Roope Hintz has 26 points (14-12—26) in 24 career games against Chicago. His 14 goals and 26 points are both his highest totals against a single opponent.
 - Hitz is the highest-scoring player in the NHL against the Blackhawks since the start of the 2020-21 season, totaling 25 points (13-12-15) in 18 games. His 13 goals against Chicago are also the most of any skater during that span.
- Mason Marchment has five points (4-1—5) in his last four games against Chicago.
- Jake Oettinger has won eight of the last nine games he has played against Chicago, posting a .903 save percentage, a
 2.67 goals-against average and one shutout in those games.
- Jason Robertson has 22 points (9-13-22) in 20 career games against Chicago. His 22 points against the Blackhawks
 are his second-highest total against a single opponent, trailing only the 24 career points (10-14-24) against Nashville.
 - Robertson's 22 points against Chicago since the start of the 2020-21 season are the second-most of any NHL skater, trailing only Dallas teammate Roope Hintz.
- Tyler Seguin has nine points (4-5—9) in his last nine games against Chicago.

DOUBLE DUTCH

- Matt Duchene enters tonight's game riding a six-game point streak dating back to Oct. 19 vs. Edmonton, totaling 12 points (6-6—12) in those games. He has recorded multi-point efforts in five of the six games he has played during his current point streak.
- Entering play Wednesday, Duchene's six-game point streak was tied for the fourth-longest active streak in the NHL. If
 he were to extend his streak tonight, it would make him the 15th skater this season to have a point in at least seven
 consecutive games.
- A goal or an assist tonight would also give Duchene a point in seven consecutive games for the first time since he had a point in eight straight games to conclude the 2021-22 regular season grom April 16 to 29, 2022.
- If he were to record at least two points tonight, Duchene would have multi-point efforts in five consecutive games for the first time in his career.
- Duchene has recorded a point in nine of the 11 games he has played this season and enters tonight's game leading the Stars in both goals (seven) and points (15). Only Logan Stankoven (nine) has more assists than Duchene this season.
- When **Duchene** has been on the ice this season during 5-on-5 play, the Stars have outscored their opponents 7-3 according to Natural Stat Trick.
- **Duchene** was named the NHL's Third Star of the Week for the week ending on Oct. 27 after totaling six points (3-3—6) in three games, a stretch that included a three-point performance (1-2—3) against Boston.

HOME COOKING

- The Stars enter tonight's matchup against Chicago with a perfect 5-0-0 record while playing at the American Airlines Center this season.
- The Stars have allowed only five goals against in total in five games at the American Airlines Center this year.
- Dallas has gone a perfect 13-for-13 on the penalty kill when playing at the AAC this season.
- Matt Duchene is the team's leading scorer while playing at the American Airlines Center this season, totaling six points (five goals, one assist) in six games played.

ROOKIE REPORT

- Logan Stankoven has 10 points (1-9—10) through his first 11 games played this season and enters tonight's game leading the Stars in assists and ranked second on the team in scoring.
- Entering play Wednesday, **Stankoven** was leading all rookies in assists and tied for the lead in rookie scoring this season. His 0.91 points per game this season was the highest mark of any first-year player to appear in at least two games this season.
- With his assist on Oct. 15 against the Sharks, **Stakoven** became just the second rookie in Stars/North Stars history to record five or more assists through his first four games of a season, joining Marc Bureau (5 in 4 GP in 1990-91) according to NHL Stats.
- He recorded three assists in Dallas' 4-3 win over the Predators on Oct. 10, making him the only rookie to have a three-point game this season.
- According to NHL Stats, Stankoven became the second rookie in franchise history to record three points in the team's season-opening contest, alongside Roland Eriksson (0-4—4 w/ MNS) on Oct. 6, 1976.
- Originally selected by the Stars in the second round (47th overall) of the 2021 NHL Draft, Stankoven appeared in 24 regular-season games for Dallas last year, totaling 14 points (6-8—14) in those contests and adding eight points (3-5—8) in 19 Stanley Cup Playoff games.
- His nine assists this season have already surpassed his total from last year and he is four points shy of matching his total from 2023-24.

CASE BY CASE BASIS

- In four games this season, Casey DeSmith has posted a 2.03 goals-against average and a .922 save percentage this season.
- Entering play Wednesday, he ranked in the top 10 in the NHL in both goals-against average (third) and save percentage (10th) this season.
- Additionally, according to MoneyPuck.com, DeSmith has saved 3.7 goals above expected this season, which was the
 eight-best mark in the NHL this year entering play Wednesday. His 0.94 goals saved above expected per 60 also ranked
 seventh in the NHL entering play Wednesday 1 according to MoneyPuck.com.
- DeSmith became the third goaltender in Stars history to record a shutout in his debut with the team when he made 25 saves in Dallas' 2-0 win over the Seattle Kraken on Oct. 13.

HOT TO GO

- Tyler Seguin has recorded at least a point in each of the last four games he has played, totaling six points (3-3—6) in those contests. He has a point in six of the seven games he has played this year.
- Miro Heiskanen has four assists in his last four games played.
- Thomas Harley has recorded a point in four of the last five games that he has played dating back to Oct. 22 against the Buffalo Sabres. He's scored one goal and added three assists during that span.

BENN THERE DONE THAT

- Stars captain Jamie Benn enters tonight's contest having played in 308 consecutive games.
- Dallas' Oct. 13 matchup against the Kraken marked the 300th consecutive game that Benn had played in, making him
 the fourth player in franchise history to play in 300 consecutive games for the team according to NHL Stats.

- Benn's current 308-game Iron Man streak is the fifth-longest active streak in the NHL.
- Benn is one of 16 players to have an active Iron Man streak of at least 200 games and is one of 11 NHL players to appear in each of his team's 246 regular-season games between 2021-22 and 2023-24.
- The Stars captain leads all Dallas players in career games played (1,123), goals (386), assists (526) and points (912). His 912 career points rank 13th among active NHL skaters, and he is the second-highest scoring fifth-round draft pick in NHL history (Alexander Mogilny; 1,032).

ONE FOR THE HISTORY BOOKS

- Esa Lindell has several franchise milestones withing reach:
 - He is six points shy of becoming the 49th player and 13th defenseman in franchise history to record 200 points with the Stars.
 - Lindell is two goals away from tying Philippe Boucher for 10th in franchise history in goals scored by a defenseman.
 - o He is also just two games shy of tying Tom Reid for 10th all-time among franchise defensemen in games played.
- Tyler Seguin is four assists away from bringing his total with the stars to 380, which would tie him with Brian Bellows for fifth-most assists by a skater in franchise history.
- Jake Oettinger's next shutout will be the 12th of his career, which will tie Jon Casey for the sixth-most in franchise history.
- Miro Heiskanen is seven assists shy of tying Dennis Hextall (216) for 23rd on the franchise's all-time assists list. He's also eight assists shy of trying Brad Maxwell (217) for 7th on the all-time assists list by defensemen.
