GAME NOTES

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- The Stars have won the last four games that they have played in Nashville, outscoring the Predators 19-7 in those contests.
- Dallas has earned at least a point in 13 of the 17 road games they have played against Nashville since the start of the 2017-18 season, going 8-4-5 in those matchups.
- Since the start of the 2017-18 season, the Dallas Stars have topped the NHL in wins (15), points (38), road wins (eight), road points (21) and goals scored (95) against the Predators.
- If he plays, tonight will mark the first NHL game of Oskar Bäck's career. Bäck was originally drafted by the Stars in the third round (75th overall) of the 2018 NHL Draft.
 - o When Bāck makes his NHL debut, he will become the seventh player drafted by the Stars between 2017 and 2024 to play in at least one regular-season game for Dallas.

PREDATORS TO PREY

- Jamie Benn has totaled 42 points (16 goals, 26 assists) in 65 career games against the Predators, which is tied with Edmonton forward Leon Draisaitl and Los Angeles forward Anze Kopitar for the second-most among all active NHL skaters.
 - o Benn's 42 points against Nashville are the most by a Stars skater in franchise history.
- Matt Duchene has totaled 36 points (14 goals, 22 assists) in 38 regular-season games against the Predators, with 17 of those points (eight goals, nine assists) coming in 18 games played in Nashville. Duchene's 36 career points rank ninth all-time among active NHL skaters.

- Duchene has five points (three goals, two assists) in four games against the Predators as a member of the Stars.
- Thomas Harley enters tonight's game riding a three-game assist streak against the Predators, totaling four assists during that span. A goal or an assist tonight would give him points in four consecutive games against a single opponent for the first time in his career.
 - He previously recorded an assist in three consecutive games against the Vegas Golden Knights from April 26, 2022 to Oct. 17, 2023.
- Miro Heiskanen has six points (two goals, four assists) in his last six games against Nashville. His six points against the
 Predators since the start of the 2022-23 season are tied for fourth among all NHL defensemen, trailing only Vancouver's
 Quinn Hughes (11) and Colorado's Cale Makar (nine).
- Roope Hintz has totaled 23 career points (11 goals, 12 assists) in 25 regular-season games against Nashville, his highest total against a single opponent. He enters tonight's game having totaled four points (two goals, two assists) in the last four games he has played at Bridgestone Arena.
- Wyatt Johnston has five points (three goals, two assists) in four career road games against the Predators, including recording four points (two goals, two assists) in the two teams' last meeting on Feb. 15, 2024.
- Mason Marchment has tallied three assists in his last three games against Nashville.
- Jason Robertson enters tonight's game riding an eight-game point streak against the Predators dating back to Oct. 13, 2022, totaling 14 points (three goals, 11 assists) during that span.
 - o **Robertson** has totaled 23 points (nine goals, 14 assists) in 20 career games against Nashville, his highest assist and point total against a single opponent.
 - His 1.15 points-per-game against the Predators rank 14th among active NHL skaters that have played Nashville at least 10 times in their career.
 - His eight-game point streak is tied for the second-longest of his career against a single opponent (Detroit; 10, Calgary; eight, Carolina; eight).
- Tyler Seguin has nine points (three goals, six assists) in his last eight games against the Predators and enters tonight's
 contest riding a three-game point streak against Nashville, totaling five points (two goals, three assists) in those
 matchups.

START YOUR ENGINES

- Tonight marks the first Dallas Stars game of the 2024-25 season. A win tonight would give the Stars victories in five consecutive home openers dating back to the 2020-21 season.
 - o The Stars are one of four NHL teams to have an active season-opening win streak of at least four games, with the others being the Boston Bruins, Carolina Hurricanes and Vegas Golden Knights, who have each won their last five season openers.
- Dallas has outscored its opponents 16-4 in its last four season openers.
- The Stars will face off against the Predators in their season opener for the third time in the last five seasons. They'll look for their third-consecutive win after defeating the Predators 7-0 on Jan. 21, 2021, and 4-1 on Oct. 13, 2022.
 - o Both previous matchups have been played in Nashville.
 - o In all, the Stars have played the Predators in their first game of the season four times (2022, 2020, 2009, 2001), posting a 3-0-1 record in those contests.
- 2024-25 also marks the fourth time in the last five seasons that the Stars are beginning their season on the road. Dallas went 3-0-0 in those road games.
- Jamie Benn leads all active Stars skaters in scoring in season openers, totaling seven points (three goals, four assists) in 13 games.
- Wyatt Johnston has recorded a point in each of the season opening games that he has played in. A goal or an assist
 tonight would make him the 20th player in franchise history and the first since Devin Shore (2016-17 to 2018-19) to
 record a point in three consecutive season openers according to NHL Stats.

FOR PETE'S SAKE

- Dallas' next win will mark Head Coach **Pete DeBoer's** 100th behind the Stars bench. He is set to become the fourth Stars head coach (since 1993-94) to record at least 100 regular-season wins with the team, joining Hen Hitchcock (319), Dave Tippett (271) and Lindy Ruff (165).
- Since the start of the 2022-23 season **DeBoer's** first as the team's head coach the Stars have posted a 99-42-23 record for a .674 win percentage, which is tied for the third-best mark in the NHL during that span.
 - Only Jim Montgomery (Boston; 112), Rod Brind'Amour (Carolina; 104) and Jared Bednar (Colorado; 101) have recorded more regular-season wins since the starts of the 2022-23 season
- DeBoer has posted a 612-421-146 record over the course of his coaching career with the Dallas Stars, Vegas Golden Knights (2019-20 to 2021-22), San Jose Sharks (2015-16 to 2019-20), New Jersey Devils (2011-12 to 2014-15) and Florida Panthers (2008-19 to 2010-11). His 612 career wins rank 23rd all-time among all NHL coaches and rank fifth all-time among active coaches.

- If they dress, tonight's contest will mark the first game in a Stars uniform for 2024 free agent signings Colin Blackwell, Casey DeSmith, Mathew Dumba, Ilya Lyubushkin and Brendan Smith.
- If any of the four skaters were to score tonight, they would become the 58th player in Stars history (since 1993) to score in their first game with Dallas and the 26th to do so in a season opener according to NHL Stats.
 - o **Wyatt Johnston** and **Mason Marchment** are the two current Dallas skaters to score in their Stars debut, with both doing so in the 2022-23 season opener on Oct. 13, 2022 against the Nashville Predators.
- Tonight's game will also mark the first time that Mavrik Bourque, Oscar Bäck and Logan Stankoven are on the team's
 opening night roster.
 - Stankoven made his NHL debut on Feb. 24, 2024 at Carolina, totaling 14 points (six goals, eight assists) in 24 regular-season games before adding eight points (three goals, five assists) in 19 Stanely Cup Playoff games.
 His 14 points from Feb. 24 through the end of the 2023-24 regular season tied for fifth among all NHL rookies.
 - Mavrik Bourque has previously played in one game for the Stars, making his NHL debut on April 6, 2024 against the Chicago Blackhawks.
 - o Bäck's first game this season will mark his NHL debut.

BROADWAY BOYS

- Matt Duchene played for Nashville for four seasons (2019-20 to 2022-23), recording 197 points (84 goals, 113) in 197 regular-season games and adding nine points (five goals, four assists) in 17 Stanley Cup Playoff games. Duchene was the third-highest scoring Predator during his tenure with the team, and only Filip Forsberg (94) scored more goals than him during those four seasons.
- Colin Blackwell played part of the 2018-19 and 2019-20 seasons with the Predators, totaling 10 points (three goals, seven assists) in 33 regular-season games.
- Stars Director of Player Personnel **Rich Peverley** played for the Nashville from 2006-07 to 2008-09, recording 20 points (seven goals, 13 assists) in 73 regular-season games.

ONE FOR THE HISTORY BOOKS

- Roope Hintz enters tonight's game three goals shy of becoming the 18th skater in franchise history to score 150 goals
 with the team.
- Tyler Seguin is eight assists away from bringing his total with the stars to 380, which would tie him with Brian Bellows for fifth-most assists by a skater in franchise history.
- Esa Lindell is nine points shy of becoming the 49th player and 13th defenseman in franchise history to record 200 points with the Stars. He is also just three goals away from tying Philippe Boucher (52) for the 10th-most goals among defensemen in franchise history.

BENN THERE DONE THAT

- Jamie Benn enters tonight's game having played in 297 consecutive games, which is the fifth-longest active such streak in the NHL. He is one of 15 players to have an active Iron Man streak of at least 200 games.
- Benn is one of 11 NHL players to appear in each of his team's 246 regular-season games since the start of the 2021-22 season.
- Currently three games shy, Benn is set to become the fourth player in franchise history to play in 300 consecutive games for the team according to NHL Stats.

• The Stars captain leads all Dallas players in career games played (1,112), goals (383), assists (524) and points (907). His 907 career points rank 12th among active NHL skaters, and he is the second-highest scoring fifth-round draft pick in NHL history (Alexander Mogilny; 1,032).

FIRST THING'S FIRST

Dallas will open the 2024-25 season with 11 former first-round picks on its roster; Mavrik Bourque (DAL; 2020), Matt Duchene (COL; 2009), Matt Dumba (MIN; 2012), Thomas Harley (DAL; 2019), Miro Heiskanen (DAL; 2017), Wyatt Johnston (DAL; 2021) Nils Lundkvist (NYR; 2018), Jake Oettinger (DAL; 2017), Tyler Seguin (BOS; 2010), Brenden Smith (DET; 2007) and Sam Steel (ANA; 2016)

- Tyler Seguin is the highest drafted player on Dallas' roster, selected by Boston with the second-overall pick in the 2010
 NHL Draft. Seguin leads all 2010 draft picks in career assists (437) and points (788), and ranks second in goals (351).
- There are two sets of Stars skaters that were taken with the same pick in different years: Matt Duchene and Miro Heiskanen were both taken with the third-overall pick, Duchene by Colorado in 2009 and Heiskanen by Dallas in 2017. Additionally, Sam Steel and Mavrik Bourque were both drafted 30th-overall Steel by Anaheim in 2016 and Bourque by Dallas in 2020.
- Six additional Stars draft picks are on Dallas' opening night roster this year: Oskar Bäck (2018; 3rd round), Jamie Benn (2007; 5th round), Roope Hintz (2015; 2nd round), Esa Lindell (2012; 3rd round), Jason Robertson (2017; 2nd round) and Logan Stankoven (2021; 2nd round).

CONNECTIONS

- Stars forward Jamie Benn, Predators forward Ryan O'Reilly and Predators defenseman Luke Schenn all played for Canada at the 2012 IIHF World Championship.
- Stars forward Colin Blackwell and Predators defenseman Jeremy Lauzon were both a part of the Seattle Kraken's inaugural roster in 2021-22.
- Stars forward Evgenii Dadonov and Predators forward Jonathan Marchessault both played for the Vegas Golden Knights during the 2021-22 season.
- Stars forward Matt Duchene and Predators forward Ryan O'Reilly played in Colorado together from 2009-10 to 2014-15. The two also played for Team Canada together at the 2013, 2015, 2016 and 2017 IIHF World Championships and the 2016 World Cup of Hockey.  - Stars forward Tyler Seguin won a gold medal with the duo at the 2015 World Championships and defenseman
 Matt Dumba won a gold medal with the two at the 2016 World Championships.
 - o Predators forward Steven Stamkos and defenseman Luke Schenn were also on the 2013 team with **Duchene** and O'Reilly. Stamkos played again with the two at the 2017 World Championship.
- Stars forward Matt Duchene played for Team Canada with Predators defenseman Luke Schenn at the 2011 IIHF World Championship.
- Stars defenseman Matt Dumba and forward Sam Steel both played for the Minnesota Wild with Predators forward Gustav Nyquist during the 2022-23 season.
- Stars defenseman Matt Dumba and Predators forward Steven Stamkos both played in Tampa Bay in 2023-24.
- Stars defenseman Thomas Harley won a silver medal with Predators forward Philip Tomasino while playing for Team Canada at the 2021 IIHF World Junior Championship.
- Stars forward Roope Hintz and defenseman Esa Lindell have both played for Team Finland in international competition
 with Predators goaltender Juuse Saros.
 - Hintz and Saros played together at the 2015 and 2016 IIHF World Junior Championships, winning a gold medal in 2016.
 - Lindell and Saros played together at the 2014 IIHF World Junior Championship, the 2015 and 2016 IIHF World Championship. They won a gold medal in 2014 and a silver medal in 2016.
- Stars defenseman **Brendan Smith** and Predators forward Gustav Nyquist were teammates in Detroit from 2011-12 to 2016-17.
- Stars defenseman **Brendan Smith** and Predators defenseman Brady Skjei both played for the New York Rangers from 2016-17 to 2019-20. The two then reunited in Carolina for the 2021-22 season.
- Stars forward Sam Steel and Predators defenseman Luke Schenn both played for the Anaheim Ducks in 2018-19.
- Stars forward Sam Steel won a gold medal with Predators defenseman Dante Fabbro while playing for Team Canada at the 2018 IIHF World Junior Championship.
