TOP NOTES

Tonight's game marked the fourth consecutive game that the Sabres have recorded the first goal of the game.

By scoring his 13th goal of 2023-24 in the first period of tonight's game, JJ Peterka surpassed his previous single-season career high in goals scored, which he set in 77 games last season. It marked the second time he has recorded a goal against Ottawa in his career.

Dylan Cozens registered the primary assist on Peterka's goal and is now tied for the lead among all Sabres skaters in primary assists this season. 13 of his 15 assists in 2023-24 have been primary assists.

Tage Thompson has now notched eight points (7+1) in his last six games against Ottawa, including at least one point in each of his last four games against the Senators. He is the first Sabres skater since Kyle Okposo from Nov. 29. 2016 to Feb. 15, 2018 (3+3; five games) to record a point streak of four or more games against Ottawa.

Thompson has recorded 12 points (7+5) in his last nine games, including eight points (5+3) in his last six games.

Thompson has two multi-goal games in his last four games played and tonight marked his third multi-goal game of the season. He also recorded two goals against Ottawa on Oct. 24.

Rasmus Dahlin recorded the primary assist on both of Thompson's goals and he has recorded five points (2+3) in his last four games. He has tallied an assist on 31 total goals scored by Thompson in his career and 21 of those assists have been primary assists.

Dahlin has now recorded a point in four consecutive home games against Ottawa, which gives him the longest home point streak ever against the Senators by a Sabres defenseman.

Peyton Krebs' goal was his third goal of the season and his first since Dec. 11 vs. Arizona. Eric Robinson recorded the lone assist on the play, his second assist in his last three games.

Cozens' empty-net goal at 19:57 of the third period was the first goal since Dec. 19 vs. Columbus and his third empty-net goal of his career.
