PRACTICE UPDATE:

- The Stars have the day off on Friday, March 1. They'll hold morning skate on Saturday, March 2 at 10:30 a.m. CT at American Airlines Center prior to their game against the San Jose Sharks at 7 p.m. CT.

NOTES

- The Stars extended their home point streak against the Jets to nine games (8-0-1 dating to Oct. 6, 2018) with a 4-1 victory on Thursday. With the win against Winnipeg, the Stars (36-17-9, 81 points) overtook the Jets (37-16-5, 79 points) for first place in the Central Division standings.

- With a goal in the first period, forward **Jason Robertson** (1-0—1) recorded his third consecutive 20-goal season. Only five players have recorded a longer stretch with the Stars since they relocated to Dallas: **Mike Modano** (8), **Jamie Benn** (6), **Tyler Seguin** (6), **Joe Pavelski** (4) and **Loui Eriksson** (4). Robertson continues to pace the Stars in points (20-39—59) in 62 GP.

- Logan Stankoven (1-0—1) scored in his third straight game and became the fifth Stars rookie in the past five years to record a three-game goal streak (3-1—4), joining Wyatt Johnston (2x: 5 GP & 3 GP in 2022-23), Jason Robertson (3 GP in 2020-21), Denis Gurianov (2x: 3 GP in 2019-20) and Roope Hintz (3 GP in 2018-19).

- Forward **Joe Pavelski** (1-1—2) recorded his 10th multi-point game of the season with a goal and an assist. The last player to record at least that many in a season at age 39 or older was **Jaromir Jagr** in 2015-16, when he posted 16 multi-point games at 43 years old. Pavelski (4-2—6 in 4 GP) scored his fourth career goal in a game on Feb. 29. The only players in NHL history with as many entering Thursday were **Brayden Schenn** (4-0—4 in 2 GP) and **Marian Hossa** (4-0—4 in 2 GP).

- Forward **Wyatt Johnston** (0-1—1) extended his point streak to four games (1-3—4) with an assist, one shy of his career high (five, done twice; last: March 13-21, 2023). With the assist, Johnston tied **Tom McCarthy** (84) for the third-most points by a player before age 21 in franchise history. The only others with more: **Brian Bellows** (210) and **Mike Modano** (139).

- Forward **Roope Hintz** (1-1—2) tallied his team-leading 24th goal of the season as part of a multi-point performance. - Goaltender **Jake Oettinger** made 25 saves en route to his 100th career win (100-45-23 in 177 GP). He became the third-fastest U.S.-born goaltender in NHL history to reach the mark behind **Frank Brimsek** (150 GP) and **Jimmy Howard** (171 GP). He also became the second-fastest goaltender in franchise history to reach 100 wins, trailing only **Ed Belfour** (174 GP).
