AT A GLANCE

THE OHIO ST(REAK)

The Kings skate into tomorrow's contest riding a six-game point streak against the Blue Jackets (5-0-1), dating back to March 4, 2022. This is tied for the fourth-longest active point streak against any one opponent for the Kings, and is one of six of the team's point streaks of at least six games in length. The Kings have not allowed a power-play goal in each of their last six against the Blue Jackets at Crypto.com Arena, dating back to March 1, 2018. This is one of 16 streaks of at least six games all-time where the Kings have not allowed a power-play goal against any one opponent, and is the third of such length vs. Columbus in team history.

GAVY'S DANCING

After scoring his first goal of the season last night against the Canucks, defenseman **Vladislav Gavrikov** is set to square off against his former team while on a three-game point streak (1-2=3). This marks the sixth time in the defender's career that he has established a point streak of three games and is his second such streak since being acquired by the Kings from the Blue Jackets during the 2022-23 campaign (Last: 2-1=3, 3 GP; April 6 - April 10, 2023). Gavrikov looks to push that run to a career-long fourth game should he record a point in tomorrow's game. Through the first 15 games of the season, only Florida's **Gustav Forsling** (+11) has maintained a higher plus/minus rating than Gavrikov (+10) while playing 20:00 or more per game.

IT'S A BEAUT, CLARKE

Defenseman **Brandt Clarke** suits up for tomorrow's matchup against the Blue Jackets leading the Kings with 11 assists on the campaign. The Nepean, Ontario native trails only Colorado's **Cale Makar** (18) and Winnipeg's **Josh Morrissey** (14) for the most among blueliners this season. The 21-year-old sits tied for third on the Kings in points with 12 points (1-11=12), trailing only **Anze Kopitar** (5-10=15) and **Alex Laferriere** (8-6=14). Clarke has six points (1-5=6) in five games at Crypto.com Arena so far this season, including his second three-plus point game of the season – and career – last Wednesday, Oct. 30 against the Golden Knights. Clarke is one of five blueliners in team history to record three or more points in multiple games before turning 22 years of age.
