TREVOR CARRICK ranks tied for second among league defensemen in points (3-12=15) and tied for third in assists, while also leading the Gulls in both categories. Carrick recorded his second three-point-game of the season Nov. 21 @ San Jose (1-2=3).

OLEN ZELLWEGER ranks second among league rookie defensemen in points (3-10=13) and assists. Zellweger recorded 1-4=5 points through three games from Nov. 21-25.

PAVOL REGENDA ranks fourth in the league in goals (10) and leads San Diego in the category while ranking tied for second in points (10-3=13).

CHASE DE LEO has recorded 1-3=4 points through his first two games of the season after beginning the campaign on Injured reserve. The Gulls captain has 55-87=142 points with San Diego, surpassing Kalle Kossita (51-90=141) for third-most points in Gulls AHL history.

TOMAS SUCHANEK appeared in his first career AHL game, stopping 23-of-24 shots to earn his first win and help the Gulls snap their 13-game losing streak, Nov. 25 vs. Chicago.

BEN KING ranks second among Gulls leaders in goals (6), tied for fourth in assists (5) and third in scoring (6-5=11). King converted on his first career penalty shot Nov. 24 vs. Chicago and tallied his first career multi-goal game (2-0=2) Nov. 29 vs. Texas.

ANDREW AGOZZINO ranks tied for second among Gulls leaders in points (2-11=13) and recorded his first three-point effort of the season Nov. 21 @ San Jose (1-2=3).
