AT A GLANCE

KOPI LOVES DUCK HUNTING

Captain Anze Kopitar enters tomorrow's contest against the Pacific Division rival Ducks as the most productive player against Anaheim in NHL history. With 16 points (5-11=16) over his last 15 games against the Orange County based club and five (0-5=5) in his last five at Crypto.com Arena, no skater has earned more points against Anaheim than Kopitar's 88 (31-57=88). The centerman is also one of six skaters in NHL history to record at least 30 goals against the Ducks.


KEEPERS OF THE CASTLE

Following their blank sheet against the Edmonton Oilers on Saturday afternoon, the Kings continue their four-game homestand having posted 43 games allowing two goals or fewer this season, the second most such contests behind the Winnipeg Jets (44). By stonewalling all 27 of Edmonton's shots on goal on Saturday, goaltender Darcy Kuemper secured his fifth shutout of the season and improved his record to 28-10-7 on the campaign to that point. With 26 saves on 28 shots faced on Monday against Seattle, Kuemper became the fourth goaltender in the NHL's expansion era (since 1967-68) to allow two or fewer goals in 14 consecutive starts. He joins Miikka Kiprusoff (16 GS in 2003-04), Dwayne Roloson (14 GS in 2003-04), and Martin Brodeur (14 GS in 1997-98).

DUCK DUCK JUICE


Adrian Kempe skates into Thursday's contest with 31 points (17-14=31) in 36 career games vs. Anaheim, including an active eight-game home point streak against the Ducks (3-8=11). He is joined by L'ubomir Visnovsky (9GP, 1-2=10), Anze Kopitar (8 GP, 3-10=13) and Luc Robitaille (8 GP, 5-8=13) as the only skaters in Kings history to have recorded a home point streak of at least eight games vs. Anaheim. As part of his 36 career games against the Ducks, Kempe established a career-long 10-game point streak against the Ducks from May 1, 2021, to Feb. 24, 2024, to mark the second longest point streak by a Kings skater against the Ducks behind Kopitar's 11-game run (6-9=15) from April 12, 2014, to April 7, 2016.


