#### **PLAYER NOTES**

- Troy Stecher scored for the Maple Leafs at 5:24 of the first period, posting his first goal of the season and first goal as a Maple Leaf. Stecher also recorded the secondary assist on Joshua's goal, posting his third assist of the season. Stecher marked the 14th multi-point game of his NHL career. Stecher has recorded an assist in three-consecutive games (1G, 3A), tying the longest assist streak of his NHL career which he has marked on three occasions.
- **Dakota Joshua** scored the game-winning goal for Toronto at 7:54 of the first period, posting his fourth goal of the season. Joshua marked the 10th game-winning goal of his NHL career. Joshua also recorded the secondary assist on Stecher's goal, posting his fourth assist of the season. Joshua marked the 14th multi-point game of his NHL career. Joshua has scored in back-to-back outings for the fifth occasion of his NHL career, recording three points in his last two games (2A, 1A).
- Scott Laughton scored for the Maple Leafs at 12:18 of the third period, posting his first goal of the season.
- **John Tavares** capitalized on Florida's empty net at 19:41 of the third period, posting his 13th goal of the season.
- **Bobby McMann** registered the primary assist on Stecher's goal and the primary assist on Joshua's goal, improving to six assists recorded this season. McMann tied a single-game career-high in assists with two which he has marked on three occasions during his career. McMann marked the 14th multi-point game of his NHL career. McMann has recorded four points in his last two games (2G, 2A).
- **Auston Matthews** posted the primary assist on Tavares' goal, recording his eighth assist of the season. Matthews has posted an assist in three-consecutive games (3A), posting four points (1G, 3A) during his assist streak.
- **Max Domi** registered the secondary assist on Tavares' goal, recording his sixth assist of the season. Domi has recorded an assist in back-to-back games (3A).
- **Joseph Woll** stopped 26 of 27 shots he faced in tonight's win.
- Morgan Rielly was on the ice for a team-high 26 Toronto shot attempts-for at 5-on-5.
- **Matthew Knies** finished the game with a team-high 5-on-5 shot attempt percentage of 62.96 percent (17 for, 10 against).

#### **TEAM NOTES**

- The Maple Leafs were 0-for-3 on the power play and 1-for-1 on the penalty kill tonight.
- Toronto has posted a 4-7-0 record on the road this season.
- The Maple Leafs have earned a win in back-to-back games and have recorded a win in three of their last four games.

The Maple Leafs have scored on their first shot of the game in three-consecutive games for the first time since 2009-10, when real-time shot data was officially tracked, per NHL Stats. The Maple Leafs became the 15th team in league history to do so and became the first club to do so with all three goals scored by defensemen. The team only trails the league record by one game which was set by Tampa Bay in the 2001-02 season when they scored on the first shot of the game in four-consecutive outings.
