AT A GLANCE

BATTLE OF THE BULLDOGS

Tomorrow's game will feature a trio of University of Minnesota-Duluth alumni, including Kings defenseman **Mikey Anderson** (2017-19) and Winnipeg skaters **Dylan Samberg** (2017-20) and **Alex Iafallo** (2013-2017). During their collegiate years, Anderson's defensive partner was Samberg. Two of the three skaters sit in the top five on the all-time games played list among active Minnesota-Duluth alumnus in the NHL with injured Jet **Neal Pionk** (2015-17) placed third on the list.

KING OF KINGS

Captain **Anze Kopitar** became the 15th skater in NHL history to record 15 separate 40-assist seasons by posting his 40th, 41st, and 42nd assists of the season on Sunday against San Jose. Only three other players on that list were not born in North America: **Nicklas Lidstrom** (16 from 1991-92 – 2010-11), Jaromir Jagr (15 from 1992-93 – 2013-14) and **Stan Mikita** (15 from 1961-62 – 1977-78). He enters tomorrow's matchup against the Jets on a seven-game point streak (7-4=11) against the Manitoba-based franchise, dating back to Feb. 23, 2023. All three of Kopitar's assists on Sunday against San Jose were the primary set-up on their respective goals, bringing his career totals to 480 in the category and passing **Marcel Dionne** (479A1) for the most primary assists in franchise history. The first of the trio, which marked the eventual game-winner, was also assisted by defenseman **Drew Doughty**. The duo has now factored on the same goal 309 times, marking the second most instances by a forward-defenseman combination in League history behind only **Wayne Gretzky** and **Paul Coffey** (350).

PHIL-LING UP THE NET

Forward **Phillip Danault** (1-0=1) returns to Crypto.com Arena on a five-game point streak (2-3=5) in the building after scoring his eighth goal of the season on Sunday vs. San Jose. Danault can extend the streak he started on March 22 in tonight's meeting with the Winnipeg Jets. The centerman tallied the game-winning goal in Winnipeg's last visit to DTLA on Nov. 27, 2024, and has 23 points (9-14=23), including a trio of game-winners, in 27 career games played against the Jets.
