# **MATCHUP NOTES**

- ★ After going 19-39-11 vs. Detroit from 2000-12, the Blue Jackets are 29-13-4 in the last 13 seasons.
- ★ CBJ have points in four of the last five road games (3-1-1) and are 14-5-3 in their last 22 games played at Detroit since Feb. 21, 2013.
- ★ The road team has recorded points in eight of the last 10 games of the series (7-2-1).
- the teams have combined for seven or more goals in 11 of the past 14 contests, including the last five-straight.
- ★ The winning team has scored four or more goals in 14 consecutive games since May 7, 2021 and in 16 of the last 18 in the overall series dating back to Mar. 2, 2021.
- The Jackets have killed off 18-of-20 (90.0 pct.) penalties in last eight contests at Detroit.
- ★ CBJ have scored a power play goal in three of the past four meetings overall (3-of-7; 42.9 pct.).



# JACKET TO WATCH - D Zach Werenski

Has 4-16-20 with 6 multi-point efforts in 25 career GP vs. the Wings. Has tallied 3-10-13 with 4 multi-point outings in last 7 contests against the club. Also has 1-6-7 in last 4 GP at Detroit.





#### RED WING TO WATCH - RW Patrick Kane

Has 28-58-86 with 24 multi-point efforts in 64 career GP against Columbus. Has points in 22 of the last 25 matchups (13-31-44). Has points in 15 of last 16 home contests (8-20-28).



### **TEAM NOTES**

- \* CBJ earned points for the sixth time in the last seven games (4-1-2) with a 3-2 OT win at Toronto on Thursday.
- ★ The Jackets have played in seven one-goal games in their past eight overall (4-1-2) and have seen 11 of their last 14 contests dating back to Oct. 25 decided by a single goal (7-2-2).
- CBJ, who are tied for the NHL lead in one-goal games in 2025-26 (14, 66.7 pct. of contests), finished with a franchise-high 61.4 pct. of their games in one-goal decisions in 2019-20 (43-of-70).
- \* The club, which is in a stretch of nine-of-12 games played on the road from Nov. 2-24, began a four-game road trip (1-1-0) at Winnipeg on Tuesday and finishes at Washington on Nov. 24.
- ★ Columbus plays its first of five matinee games (3:30 pm local start or earlier) this season on Saturday (also Dec. 6 at FLA, Jan. 3 vs. BUF, Jan. 4 vs. PIT, Jan. 10 at COL).

#### **PLAYER NOTES**

- ★ C Charlie Coyle has 1-4-5 in the last five contests and sits one point shy from 500 for his NHL career (192-307-499, 971 GP).
- \* C Adam Fantilli scored his first career OT winner on Thursday to cap off his first three-point game of 2025-26 (2-1-3).

  He has notched goals in five of the past seven games (6-2-8) and has points in six of the last eight (6-4-10).
- ★ G Jet Greaves, who has earned points in six-straight games since Nov. 10 (4-0-2), leads the NHL in wins and ranks fifth in SV% (min. 3 GP) since Nov. 11 with a 4-0-1 record. 2.07 GAA and .925 SV%.
- ★ LW Dmitri Voronkov has goals in three of the past four games (3-2-5) and leads the team in goals, PPG and plus/minus rating (tied) this season with 9-9-18, 3 PPG and +9 in 21 contests.
- ★ D Zach Werenski, who has points in five-straight outings (2-6-8), passed Cam Atkinson (402) for the second-most points in franchise history (119-284-403, 588 GP) with a three assist outing at Toronto on Thursday. The Grosse Pointe, Michigan native ranks second in the NHL in TOI/GP and third-T among league blueliners in goals and multi-point efforts as well as fourth-T in points with 6-13-19, 6 multi-point GP and 26:47 TOI in 21 contests.
