PRACTICE UPDATE:

- The Stars will practice at 12 p.m. CT on Saturday, Nov. 25 at Comerica Center (2601 Avenue of the Stars, Frisco, TX 75034).

NOTES:

- Forward **Wyatt Johnston** (20 years and 194 days) lit the lamp twice (2-0—2) against Calgary for his eighth and ninth goals of the season - tied with **Joe Pavelski**, who also had a goal, for the most among all Stars players. Johnston is now the second-youngest player this season to lead their team in goals (tied or outright) after **Connor Bedard** (18 years and 130 days).
- Forward **Jason Robertson** (1-1—2) recorded his sixth goal of the 2023-24 campaign as part of a multi-point night. Robertson has points in 10 of his past 13 games (5-9—14) and 13 of his past 17 (6-12—18).
- With a goal, forward **Joe Pavelski** (1-0—1) extended his point streak to six consecutive games (4-3—7) to become the third player in franchise history (1967-present) to record a point streak of six or more games at age 39 or older. He joined **Ray Whitney** (6 GP at age 40 in 2012-13) and **Dean Prentice** (6 GP at age 40 in 1972-73).
- Captain **Jamie Benn** finished the game with two assists (0-2—2). Benn has points in three of his past four games (1-3—4) and 14 points (4-10—14) in 19 GP.
- Forward **Evgenii Dadonov** recorded his second multi-point game of the season with two assists (0-2—2).
- Goaltender **Jake Oettinger** made 20 saves on 26 shots.
