# **TOP NOTES**

Mattias Samuelsson's goal marked his fourth in 18 games this season. As a result, he tied his previous single-season career high in goals, which he set in 62 games in 2024-25. He is tied for sixth among all NHL defensemen in goals this season. Samuelsson's tally came unassisted, which marked the first unassisted goal of his career.

Samuelsson's two-point performance (1+1) in tonight's game marked the sixth multi-point game of his career and the third time he has registered at least one goal and one assist in a single game.

Tage Thompson's goal gave him an eight-game point streak against the Flames and he has posted nine points (7+2) in that span. The goal made him the first Sabres skater to record a point streak of eight or more games against the Flames since Dale Hawerchuk from Nov. 17, 1990 to Dec. 10, 1993 (eight games; 0+9).

Gilbert Perreault (twice) is the only other Sabres skater who has registered a point streak of eight or more games against Calgary.

Rasmus Dahlin assisted on Thompson's goal and has registered at least one assist in four straight home games against Calgary. With his assist, Dahlin joined Phil Housley (six games; Feb. 18, 1983 to Nov. 10, 1985; 2+7) as the only Sabres defensemen to record at least one assist in four or more consecutive home contests against the Flames.
