

Connor Mackey begins his fourth professional season in 2023-24 after signing with the Rangers as a free agent on July 1, 2023. Mackey produced seven points (3G, 4A) in 30 combined games with the Calgary Flames and the Arizona Coyotes last season. The 6-foot-2, 197-pound blueliner has recorded 11 points (4G, 7A) in 39 career NHL games and has 52 points (8G, 44A) in 80 career American Hockey League contests, all with the Stockton Heat. Mackey earned an AHL All-Star Game selection in 2020-21 and has represented the United States at two IIHF World Championships (2021 and 2023), helping the U.S. capture the bronze medal in 2021.
