- Defenseman **Thomas Harley** (1-1—2) who scored 38 seconds into overtime to secure the win for the Stars is the only defenseman in the league to score multiple overtime goals this season. Harley's OT winner was his 10th goal of 2023-24 and became the sixth defenseman in franchise history to record as many in a single season at age 22 or younger, following **Brad Maxwell** (18 in 1977-78), **Craig Hartsburg** (3x: 17 in 1981-82, 14 in 1979-80 & 13 in 1980-81), **Miro Heiskanen** (12 in 2018-19), **Derian Hatcher** (12 in 1993-94) and **John Klingberg** (11 in 2014-15).
- Harley has multiple points in two consecutive games (1-3—4) and ranks second among Stars blueliners with 27 points (10-17—27).
- Defenseman **Miro Heiskanen** returned to the lineup after missing the past 10 games with a lower-body injury and scored the game-tying goal at the 10:31 mark of the third period. He also led the team in TOI (25:33). Heiskanen paces Stars d-men with 28 points (5-23—28) this season.
- Forward **Matt Duchene** tallied his 16th goal of the season just 2:22 into the game. The goal gave him points in four of his past five games (2-2—4) and 43 points (15-27—43) overall (47 GP).
- Forward **Mason Marchment** picked up his 20th assist of the season to give him points in two consecutive games (1-1-2)
- Goaltender Jake Oettinger made 18 saves on 21 shots for his 15th victory of the season (15-9-2).
