TODAY'S MATCHUP

● The Maple Leafs are facing off against the Calgary Flames tonight at the Scotiabank Saddledome in the second of two games between the clubs this season. The Maple Leafs won their first game of the season against the Flames in a 4-3 final on October 28th at Scotiabank Arena. Toronto posted a 2-0-0 record against Calgary during the 2024-25 season. Toronto has earned a win in seven-consecutive games against the Flames while capturing a point in 12 of their last 13 meetings [11-1-1]. Toronto is skating in their third game of a four-game road trip [1-1-0]. The team has posted a 9-12-3 record on the road this season. The Maple Leafs are skating in their first game of a back-to-back tonight, taking on the Edmonton Oilers tomorrow night at Rogers Place. The Maple Leafs have posted a 3-5-0 record in the first game of back-to-back this season.

● The Maple Leafs won 3-2 in a shootout against the Vancouver Canucks on Saturday night at Rogers Arena. William Nylander scored the game-winning goal for the Maple Leafs in Saturday's shootout, with Auston Matthews also scoring for Toronto during the shootout. Nicolas Roy and Max Domi scored a goal each for the Maple Leafs during regulation. Joseph Woll stopped 28 of 30 shots he faced in Saturday's shootout win.
