2024-25 SEASON

- Scored 80 or more points for the third-straight season with 42-40—82 in 77 GP
- Led TBL for goals (42), overtime goals (2) and shooting percentage (22.2%)
- Scored 16 power-play goals to tie Leon Draisaitl (EDM) for 2nd in the NHL behind only teammate Jake Guentzel (17)
- Named a top three finalist for the Lady Byng Memorial Trophy for the second time in his career
- Scored seven game-winning goals, second-most on TBL
- His 22.2% shooting percentage led the NHL among skaters with at least 40 GP
- Ranked fourth among TBL skaters for shots (189) and sixth for faceoff percentage (48.5%)
- Became 5th player in TBL franchise history to score 300 goals March 27 vs. UTA
- Played 600th NHL game Dec. 5 vs. SJS
- Became third-fastest player in TBL history to 600 NHL points (615 GP) on Jan. 9 vs. BOS
- His 31 power-play points tied for 13th in the NHL

2025 Playoffs

- Played in all five TBL playoff games, averaging 21:48 time on ice
- T-2nd on TBL for goals (2) and T-3rd for shots on goal (12) while tying for the team lead in even-strength goals (2)

2023-24 Season

- Recorded 90 or more points for the second-straight season and third time of his career, logging 46-44—90 in 81 GP
- Led the NHL with 12 game-winning goals
- For the second-straight season, led TBL for goals and game-winning goals while ranking second for scoring
- Ranked fourth among all TBL skaters for assists

CAREER

2023-24 Season Cont.

- Scored 31 even-strength goals, tied with Nikita Kucherov for the team lead
- Scored 15 power-play goals, second-most among TBL skaters and tied for ninth-most in the NHL
- Recorded a 20.3% shooting percentage, the highest among all TBL skaters (min. 20 GP)
- Appeared in all five playoff games and picked up five points with two goals and three assists

2022-23 Season

- Notched 95 points in 82 games, setting a career high for goals with 51
- Led TBL for goals and ranked 2nd in scoring
- One of three Bolts to play in all 82 games
- Ranked 5th in the NHL for goals and T-5th for game-winning goals (9)
- Ranked 3rd on the Bolts for shots on goal with 235
- Scored 20 power-play goals to lead the Lightning and ranked T-3rd in the NHL
- Finalist for the Lady Byng Memorial Trophy
- Set a TBL franchise record with goals in nine consecutive home games from December 6, 2022 to January 10, 2023
- Ranked 2nd in the NHL for shooting percentage (21.7%)
- Saw action in six playoff games, tallying two goals and four points

2021-22 Season

- Recorded 28-30—58 in 66 games, ranking second on TBL for goals and fifth for scoring
- Notched 50+ points for the fourth time in his six NHL seasons
- Scored 10 power-play goals to rank second on TBL
- Was third on the Bolts with 176 shots
- Set career highs for penalty minutes (33) and hits (75)
- Recorded his 201st career assist Apr. 24 at Florida to pass Tyler Johnson for 10th place in all-time TBL assists
- Ranked second among TBL forwards for average time on ice (19:28) and third for average power-play time on ice (3:36)
- Missed a month of the season (14 games from Nov. 21-Dec. 21) due to an upper-body injury
- Skated in 9 playoff games, recording 2 goals and 5 points
- Missed all of the 2nd Rd. vs. FLA and Eastern Conference Final vs. NYR due to a lower-body injury
- Returned for Games 1 and 2 of the Stanley Cup Final versus COL before missing the final four games due to a lower-body injury
- Scored the OT game-winning goal in Game 6 of the 1st Rd. versus TOR to become the second player in TBL history to score an OT goal in an elimination game

2020-21 Season

- Played in all 56 games for TBL, 1 of 5 Bolts players to appear in every game, posting 23 goals and 48 points
- Led TBL for both goals and points
- Recorded a Lightning season long-tying 7 game point streak (4 goals, 7 assists) from January 30 to February 11
- Tied for firsts on TBL for game-winning goals (6) and was 3rd for power play goals (6)
- Appeared in 23 postseason games, recording 14 goals and 23 points to go along with 8 penalty minutes
- Led the NHL for goals with 14 and power-play goals (7), and was 2nd for points
- Finished tied for 1st for game-winning tallies with 3
- Scored 9-4—13 during a 9-game point streak from Game 3 vs. Carolina through Game 6 at NY Islanders, the 2nd longest in NHL playoff history

CAREER CONT.

2019-20 Season

- Played in 66 games with TBL, posting 25 goals and 64 points to go along with a +28 rating
- Ranked 3rd on the Bolts for points and 4th for goals
- His career-high +28 rating ranked tied for 1st on the team and tied for 5th in the NHL
- Posted a career-best 11-game point streak (3 goals, 12 assists) from Jan. 29-Feb. 17
- Appeared in 23 Stanley Cup Playoff games, posting 14 goals and 33 points to go along with a +12 rating and 10 penalty minutes
- Led the NHL for goals and was 2nd for points while tying for 2nd in the NHL with 4 postseason power-play goals
- Netted the game-winning goal in the 5th overtime period against the Columbus Blue Jackets in Game 1 of their 1st round series
- Finished the Stanley Cup Final against Dallas on a 5-game point streak (5-3—8)

2018-19 Season

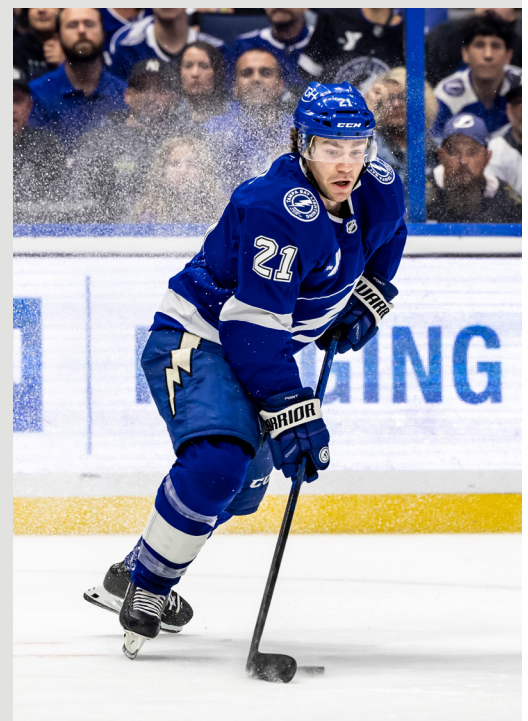
- Played in 79 games, registering 41 goals and 92 points to go along with 28 penalty minutes
- Ranked 2nd on the Lightning for goals, 3rd for assists and points
- Ranked tied for 6th in the NHL for goals and 12th for points
- Led NHL for power-play goals with 20 and is tied for 6th for power-play points (35)
- Ranked 2nd in the NHL for shooting percentage (21.5%)
- Set career highs for goals, assists and points
- Appeared in 4 Stanley Cup Playoff games, posting a goal and 5 penalty minutes

2017-18 Season

- Played in all 82 games with TBL, recording 32 goals and 66 points to go along with 24 penalty minutes
- Ranked tied for 1st in the NHL with 12 game-winning goals and 2nd in the league for overtime goals (4)
- Ranked 2nd on the Bolts for shots on goal (217) and goals
- Ranked 3rd on TBL for points and plus/minus (+18)
- Set career highs for games played, goals, assists and points
- Named to his 1st NHL All-Star Game
- Appeared in 17 Stanley Cup Playoff games, posting 7 goals and 16 points to go along with 10 penalty minutes
- Ranked tied for 2nd on the team for points and was tied for the team lead with 7 goals
- Recorded 3 goals and 6 points in the Eastern Conference Final against WSH, including 3 multi-point games
- Matched TBL franchise record for points in a playoff game, tallying 1-3—4 in Game 2 versus BOS

2016-17 Season

- Played in 68 games with TBL during his rookie season, posting 18 goals and 40 points to go along with 14 penalty minutes
- Ranked 8th in the NHL among rookies for points and tied for 9th for goals

2016-17 Season Cont.

- Notched 5 power-play goals, ranking tied for 5th in the NHL among rookies
- Posted career-best 3-point game in season finale against Buffalo, recording 2 goals and a helper
- Posted career-long point streak from 2/10-2/19 (3 goals, 2 assists)
- Missed 14 games from 12/29-1/26 with upper-body injury
- Made NHL debut on 10/13 vs. DET
- Skated in 10 games for Team Canada at the 2017 IIHF World Championships, posting 4 goals and 5 points as Canada earned the Silver Medal

2015-16 Season

- Played in 48 games for the Moose Jaw Warriors of the Western Hockey League (WHL), posting 35 goals and 88 points
- Served as captain of the Warriors for the second straight year
- Ranked 2nd on Moose Jaw for goals, assists (53) and points, while pacing the club for plus/minus (+24)

2014-15 Season

- Skated in 60 games for Moose Jaw, recording a team-best 38 goals and 87 points
- Served as captain of the Warriors
- Ranked tied for 8th in the WHL for points
