

Signed as a free agent by Buffalo on April 13, 2013, Ruhwedel has tallied 49 points (13G, 36A) in 364 career NHL games with the Sabres, Pittsburgh and New York. He's also appeared in 25 postseason contests and won the Stanley Cup with the Penguins in 2017. The San Diego, California, native has played in 211 career American Hockey League games with the Rochester Americans and the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Penguins, tallying 111 points (29G, 82A). Ruhwedel played three seasons of college hockey at UMass Lowell from 2010-13, totaling 63 points (15G, 48A) in 110 career contests, helping UMass Lowell to the Hockey East Championship in 2012-13 and earning Hockey East First All-Star Team and First-Team All-American honors.
