## AT A GLANCE

### AWAY TEAM'S CRYPTO-NITE

The Kings enter the 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs as the best team on home ice in the NHL, finishing the regular season with a 31-6-4 record in DTLA. Prior to locking up the second seed in the Pacific Division last week, the Kings capped off a four-game homestand with a 5-4 victory over the Avalanche on April 12. That result secured the team's 31st win at Crypto.com Arena this season and marked the first time in franchise history the team has reached the 30-home win mark.

### KEEPERS OF THE CASTLE

The Kings cross into the post-season after posting 45 games allowing two goals or fewer this year, trailing only the William M. Jennings Trophy-winning Winnipeg Jets (46) for the most such games this season. Counted among those contests are six shutouts, two of which (3-0 on April 5 and 5-0 on April 14) were earned against the Kings' opponent in the First Round, the Edmonton Oilers. With last Monday's blank-sheet at Rogers Place, the Kings shutout the Oilers for the second time in a single campaign for the first time since 2013-14 and joined the Minnesota Wild (2x in 2003-04; 3x in 2006-07) as the only NHL clubs to shutout Edmonton multiple times in two seasons or more. The Oilers have not been held scoreless by the same opponent twice in one season since 2020-21, when the Toronto Maple Leafs did so while the two Canadian clubs competed in the temporarily realigned North Division.

### (GAME) OF THR(ONE)S

Tomorrow, the Kings begin their quest for the Stanley Cup against the Edmonton Oilers for the fourth consecutive post-season. Per NHL PR, the Kings and Oilers are set to become the second pair of teams in the NHL's expansion era (since 1967-68) to contest an opening round series for four consecutive years, following the Bruins and Canadiens from 1984-87.

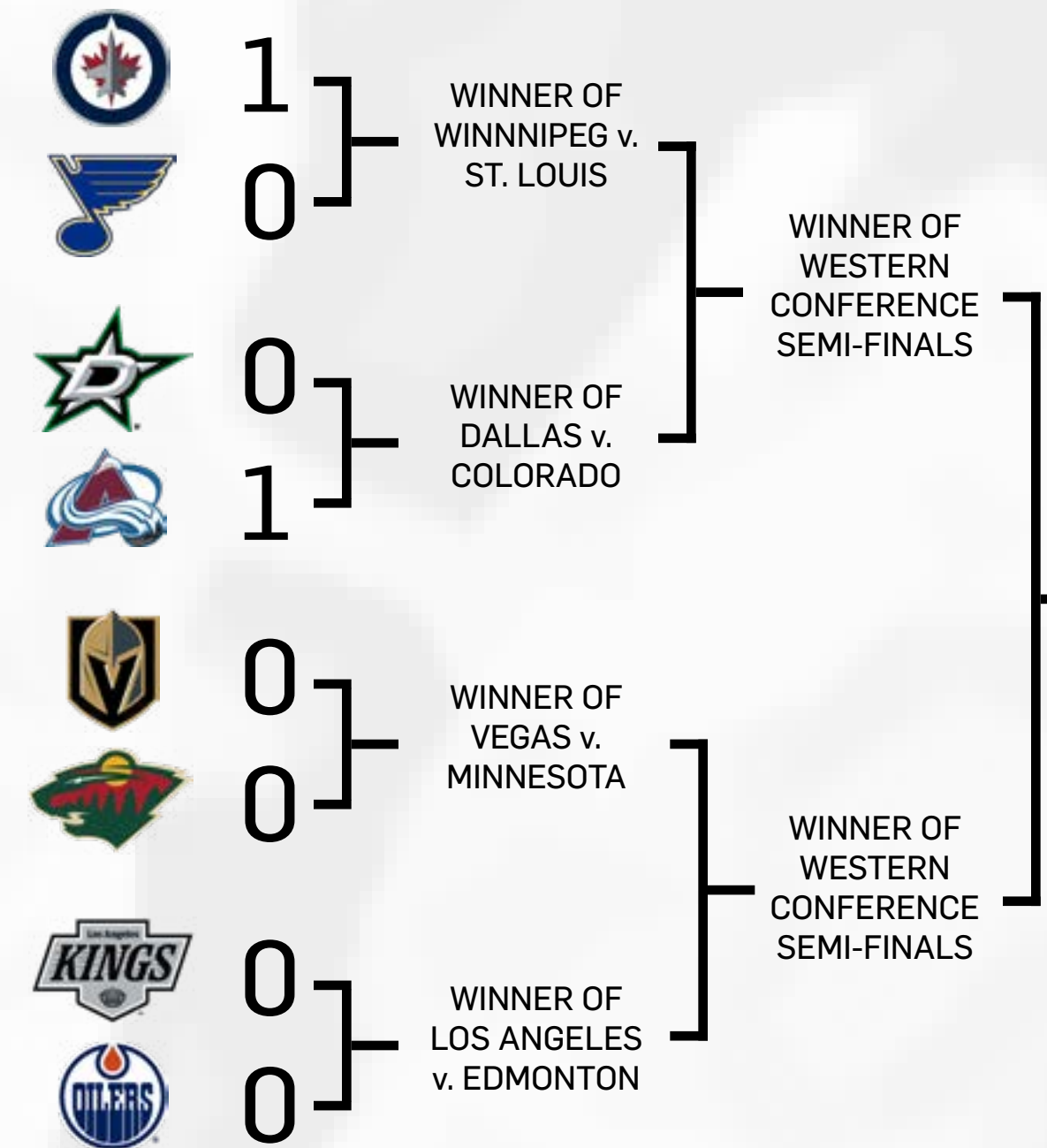
