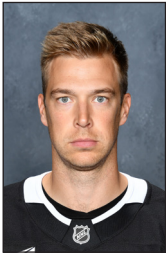

TOP NOTES

Alex Lyon recorded his 10th straight win tonight, eclipsing Gerry Desjardins' nine-game streak from Dec. 11 to 29, 1976 as the longest by a goaltender in Sabres history.

Tonight's game marked the 1,300th game Lindy Ruff has coached with Buffalo.

With the team's win tonight, Buffalo has recorded 20 wins in a 24-game span for the first time in franchise history. The Sabres have also earned 41 points in a 24-game stretch for the first time in franchise history.

Alex Tuch's hat trick was the fourth of his career, all of which have come as a member of the Sabres.

Tuch is now riding a five-game point streak against Los Angeles and he has recorded eight points (6+2) in that span. It is the longest point streak by a Sabres skater against the Kings since Jason Pominville from Dec. 19, 2008 to Oct. 14, 2017 (five games; 0+8).

With assists on two of Tuch's goals, Ryan McLeod has now posted 15 points (4+11) in his last 13 games, including at least one assist in four consecutive contests. As a result, he matched the longest assist streak of his career (four games; Jan. 8 to 14, 2026; 2+4).

With his goal, Mattias Samuelsson earned the longest point streak of his career (five games; 1+7).

Rasmus Dahlin picked up the primary assist on Samuelsson's goal. Dahlin (309 assists) ranks eighth on Buffalo's all-time assists list and needs two assists to surpass Don Luce (310 assists with Buffalo) for sole possession of seventh place.

Dahlin's (7+7 in his last 10 games including tonight) assist marked the first time he had posted 14 or more points in any 10-game span since he registered 14 points (4+10) from March 25 to April 13, 2025.

Jack Quinn set a new single-game career high with three assists in tonight's game. In his last seven games, Quinn has recorded nine points (2+7), including at least one point in four straight games (1+5).

The Sabres have earned a win in four of their last five games against the Kings, outscoring Los Angeles 18-7 in that span.
