A first-round selection (19th overall) of the Rangers in the 2009 NHL Draft, Chris Kreider has skated in 883 career NHL games, all with the Blueshirts. Across 13 seasons, he has recorded 326 goals and 256 assists for 582 points, and a plus-121 rating. This past season, he tied the franchise record for most power play goals (116). In 2023-24, he surpassed Adam Graves for the third-most goals in Rangers history (281) and the 10th most points (508), recorded his 166th career goal at MSG (regular season and playoffs) to surpass Rod Gilbert for the most in the building's history and became the third player in franchise history to score 300 goals, joining Gilbert and Jean Ratelle.
